HOW TO ACCOMPLISH THIS FORM

- 1. Prepare this form in triplicate copies. Upon registration submit the original and duplicate copies to the Local Civil Registrar and keep the third copy for your personal file.
- 2. Type or write legibly in ink on the blank spaces provided.
- 3. Fill out this form completely and accurately.
- 4. For correctness and accuracy of data, the mother or the father shall be preferred as informant over any other person.
- 5. The informant shall be asked to sign item 14 of this form upon completion. Before doing so he should review the entries for each item and make sure that the entries made therein are all correct and that the name of the child and the names of the parents are correctly spelled.
- 6. The status refers to whether or not registration is delayed. If delayed, place 2 in box 13, otherwise place 1.

PENALTY CLAUSE OF ACT NO. 8783

- 1. False Statements - Any person who shall knowingly make false statements in the forms furnished and shall cause the entry in the civil register, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one month nor more than six months or a fine of not less than two hundred pesos nor more than five hundred pesos, in the discretion of the court.
- 2. Failure to Report - Other Violations - Any person whose duty it is to report any fact concerning the civil status of a person and who knowingly fails to perform such duty, and any person convicted of having violated any of the provisions of this Act, shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred pesos nor more than five hundred pesos.
- 3. Neglect of Duty - Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Act, any local civil registrar who fails properly to perform his duties in accordance with the provisions of this Act and of the regulations issued hereunder, shall be punished for the first offense by an administrative fine in a sum equal to his salary for the month that he shall be absent from his office for more than three months and for a second or repeated offense, by removal from the service.
