EXCERPT FROM THE APPROVED MINUTES OF THE Academic Personnel Board Meeting

The reply of Dr. Romel B. Armecin, Director of EcoFarmi, to APB Resolution No. 423 s. 2020 dated October 15, 2020, to wit, "Recommending to hire a faculty member as replacement of the core technical staff who has transferred to PCC. However, the request is remanded to EcoFARMi to consider hiring a faculty member in other field of specialization such as Development Communication instead of animal science. To handle the existing animal production research programs/projects in the Institute, it can tap experts from the Department of Animal Science instead. It is also advised to provide strong justifications and supporting documents such as approved plans and projects of the Institute indicated in the OPCR, staff and development plan, and certification from an academic department that the would-be appointee will be given at least six (6) units teaching load as affiliate faculty", was presented and deliberated. Dr. Armecin stated that the EcoFARMI still need the field of Animal Science specialization who shall focus on their program on the Crop-Livestock integration with the theme on natural farming/organic agriculture. The suggestion of APB for a Dev. Communication specialization is unnecessary to the institute since they have Ms. Vellaremo (on study leave) to work on the production of IEC materials for the technologies of the institute.

Thereupon, below is the APB action which was approved by the University President.
