Dear Dr. Tulin:

The <u>Department of Animal Science – College of Agriculture and Food Science</u> (<u>DAS-CAFS</u>) is urgently needing the additional hiring of Two (2) Part-time Instructors for 1st Semester, SY 2020-2021.

The above emergency request for two (2) part-time instructor positions resulted to the overloading of teaching duties to some faculty and wherein also four (4) regular faculties who were on study leave, namely: Mr. Cyrill John P. Godinez, Asst. Prof. Ma. Rosa De Lima G. Beato, Ms. Jade Dhapnee Z. Compendio, and Mrs. Ginas Aurea A. Villagonzalo. Therefore, we are under staff of faculty to cater the following:

- The persistent increases in number of enrollees every semester taking animal science subjects: especially the BSAB-2 requiring Animal Science 195b (Practicum in Animal Science) and BSA 2 requiring Animal Science 22n (Intro to Livestock and Poultry Production), Animal Science 112 (Swine Production and Management), and Animal Science 131 (Ruminant Production) classes;
- The AnSci 200a (Field Practice, Summer Course) supposed to be offered this coming June-July 2020 is offered this 1st Semester, SY 2020-2021 (per BOR Meeting, dated April 28, 2020); and
- The approval of the sabbatical leave of Dr. Lolito C. Bestil starting August 2020 until July 2021.

The services of additional two (2) part-time instructors will accommodate the required ISO teaching load and effectively carry the undergraduate programs of the department. Please see attached Actual Summary of Faculty Workload for 1st Semester, SY 2020-2021.
