Dear Dr. Yepes:

Greetings!

The Department of Pest Management would like to extend our gratitude for approving our request to hire two Regular Faculty Positions and four Part-time Instructors.

However, with the bulk of the enrollment in Principles of Crop Protection (CPrt 21), Approaches and Practices of Pest Management (CPrt 22), General Microbiology (Micro 22), General Physiology and Toxicology (PPrt 132), and Beneficial Arthropods and Microorganisms (PPrt 172) courses, the department would still need **two (2) additional Part-time Instructors**. They will handle the additional laboratory classes of basic plant protection courses mentioned. The hiring of two more Part-time Instructors will also enable us to resolve those three to four laboratory classes scheduled in one same time-same day-same room assignments. Additionally, the department has to allot two laboratory sections for our four major Plant Protection courses (Ento 111, PPat 111, Wdsc 111, and PPrt 197) because of the almost three-fold increase (~ 50 students) of our Plant Protection major students. Lastly, the number of students is more than the projected number of enrollees per subject this semester.

In relation to this, the DPM Personnel Committee would like to recommend Ms. Lina C. Manacpo (5th rank) and Mr. Rodglen P. Alibio (6th rank) to be hired as **additional Part-time Instructors** to teach laboratory classes of the aforementioned courses for this first semester of SY 2024-2025.
