APPROVING THE PROPOSED BUDGET OF THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU) SYSTEM UNDER GENERAL FUND CONTAINED IN THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 BUDGET PROPOSAL IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO BILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (₱ 2,754,378,000.00), THE DETAILS OF WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE DOCUMENT HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE PART HEREOF

WHEREAS, National Budget Memorandum No. 153 dated December 27, 2024 set the Budget Call for Fiscal Year 2026;

WHEREAS, in the light of this budget call, the VSU submits to the Board, through the University Administrative Council, its proposed budget Two Billion Seven Hundred Fifty Four Million Three Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Pesos (₱ 2,754,378,000.00), the breakdown per program are as follows;

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WHEREAS, Regent Rosales affirmed Director Ampac's statement that the budget is expected to increase due to the STREAM to TABLE Project, which is being implemented in collaboration with the Department of Economy, Planning, and Development (DepDEV), and has a total proposed budget of ₱96.912 million;

**WHEREAS**, part of the proposed budget includes the creation of 56 new positions for the university's newly established offices, which will also cover the initial personnel for the College of Medicine;

WHEREAS, finding the UADCO's recommendation in order, the Governing Board has agreed to approve the proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion, duly seconded, and unanimously approved, be it;

**RESOLVED,** as it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Regents of Visayas State University approves the proposed 2026 budget of the Visayas State University (VSU) System Under General Fund contained in the Calendar Year 2026 Budget Proposal in the amount of Two Billion Seven Hundred Fifty Four Million Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Pesos (\$\frac{1}{2}\$,754,378,000.00), the details of which are reflected in the document hereto attached and made part hereof;

**FURTHER RESOLVED** to endorse the CY 2026 Budget Proposal to the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) for approval.

#### PROPOSAL FOR 2026 BUDGET (GENERAL FUND)

Request for BOR approval for the 2025 Budget Proposal of the Visayas State University under General Fund. In line with the National Budget Memorandum No. 153 dated December 27, 2024 which set the Budget Call for FY 2025. The basic feature is the shift to annual cash-based budget and for the whole VSU System we are proposing a budget of **Two Billion Six Hundred Fifty Seven Million Four Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Pesos** (**P 2,657,466,000.00**).
