BOR RESOLUTION NO. 96-0 Series of 2024

APPROVING THE STUDY LEAVE WITH PAY OF ENGR. JOHN ALLAN A. GULLES, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2024 TO MAY 31, 2026 AT THE ASIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLGY, THAILAND TO PURSUE MASTER'S PROGRAM IN GEOTECHNICAL AND EARTH RESOURCES ENGINEERING UNDER DOST-SEI FOREIGN GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT TO SIGN THE SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT

Whereas, the VSU Scholarship Committee for the Academic Staff endorses for approval by the Governing Board, among others, the scholarship of Engr. John Allan A. Gulles, faculty member of DCE;

Whereas, Engr. Gulles will be pursuing the Master's Program in Geotechnical and Earth Resources Engineering at Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand under DOST-SEI Foreign Graduate Scholarship, a full scholarship program funded by the Department of Science and Technology, effective August 2024 to May 2026;

Whereas, the scholarship contract that outlines the terms and conditions of the scholarship grant under which the involved parties have agreed are crafted to help protect the faculty-recipient and the University;

Whereas, the Scholarship Committee endorsement, relevant supporting documents and the scholarship contract were presented to the University Administrative Council on May 23, 2024, and obtained favourable action;

Now, therefore, on motion, duly seconded, and unanimously approved, be it;

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Regents of Visayas State University approves the study leave with pay of Engr. John Allan A. Gulles, effective August 2024 to May 2026 at the Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand to pursue Master's Program in Geotechnical and Earth Resources Engineering under DOST-SEI Foreign Graduate Scholarship and further authorizing the university president to sign the scholarship contract.
