**A Resolution Approving the Incorporation of Welding
Competency in the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Engineering (BSAE)
Curriculum Including the Offering of Short-Training Courses in Welding to
Out-of-School Youths and Request for the CHED to Fund the Purchase of
Additional Tools and Equipment in Support of the Proposal**

WHEREAS, the proposed incorporation of welding competency is the BSc. in Agricultural Engineering (BSAE) is designed to strengthen the students' technical background in basic engineering principles and concepts;

WHEREAS, the College of Engineering and Agri-Industries (CEAI) of the Main Campus is preparing for the ladderization of the BSAE degree program to keep abreast with the current programs of the CHED and TESDA on the incorporation of the Technical-Vocational Education and Training (TVET);

WHEREAS, based on the TESDA requirements for NC II welding competencies, the current BSAE curriculum can already satisfy the requirements for both Basic and Common Competencies;

WHEREAS, the CEAI would also like to provide out-of-school youths with the opportunity to gain skills and knowledge on Welding so as to provide them gainful employment after their training;


WHEREAS, the existing welding tools and equipment are dated and not sufficient for the ladderization of the BSAE curriculum as well as for the training of out-of-school youths.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the proposed incorporation of welding competencies in the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Engineering (BSAE) including the offering of short-training courses in welding to out-of-school youths and the request for the acquisition of equipment needed in support of the Welding and Automotive Ladderized Competencies in the amount of P7Million through a 50%-50% counterpart funding by CHED and VSU.


