BOR RESOLUTION NO. 03, s. 2022

A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF LED WALL AND OTHER I.T. EQUIPMENT (GOODS-22-57) OF THE AC/DC COMPONENT PARTS AND SERVICE CENTER, INC. AS THE BIDDER WITH THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) IN THE AMOUNT OF P5,500,000.00

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to *“exercise all the powers granted to the Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68 otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines”*;

WHEREAS, Paragraph (b), Section 7 of R.A. 9158 provides: *“To receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University”*;

WHEREAS, VSU is a CHED Center for Excellence (COE) in Agriculture and a National University in Region VIII, it is mandated to provide leadership in developing highly competitive human resource, relevant scientific knowledge, and innovative technologies to support the sustainable development of the Visayas Region in particular and the whole of the Philippines in general;

WHEREAS, a Purchase Request (PR) no. GF-2022-10-0211 charged against General Fund from the MMDC for the request of procurement of equipment for Smart Campus was submitted to the Office of the Head of Procurement;

WHEREAS, said PR was scheduled by the BAC Secretariat for Competitive Bidding with the project title **“Supply and Delivery and Installation of LED Wall and other I.T. Equipment (GOODS-22-57) and wit a total approved budget for the contract (ABC) of Six Million Two Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Pesos (P6,255,00.00);**

WHEREAS, five bidders responded the invitation to bid in relation to the purchase of the LED Wall and other I.T. equipment, namely, JOEBZ COMPUTER SALES AND SERVICES. AC/DC COMPONENT PART SALES AND SERVICE CENTER, INC, ACCESS MEDIACAST DIGITAL GROUP INC., AND ANJENE INDUSTRIES, INC. purchased the bidding documents for ten thousand pesos and submitted their proposals within the deadline of submission;

WHEREAS, the BAC rated that all the bidders had “passed” the bidding requirements and after the bidding process, declared that the AC/DC Component Part Sales and Service Center, Inc. as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) in the Amount of P5,500,000.00.;

WHEREAS, the proposal was endorsed by the University Administrative Council through a referendum on 21 February 2022;


WHEREAS, the same proposal was also endorsed by the VSU BOR Finance Committee through a referendum on 29 March 2022.

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve the **Supply and Delivery and Installation of LED Wall and other I.T. Equipment (GOODS-22-57) of the AC/DC Component Part Sales and Service Center, Inc. as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) in the Amount of P5,500,000.00**




Dear Mr. Chair:

WHEREAS, a Purchase Request (PR) No. GF-2022-10-02011 charged against General Fund from the MMDC for the procurement of equipment for Smart Campus was submitted to the Office of the Head for Procurement;

WHEREAS, said PR was scheduled by the BAC Secretariat for Competitive Bidding with project title "Supply, Delivery, and Installation of LED Wall and Other I.T. Equipment (GOODS-22-57)" and with a total approved budget for the contract (ABC) of Six Million Two Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php 6,255,000.00);

WHEREAS, the VSU posted an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the aforementioned project in the PhilGEPS, VSU website, and in the VSU Procurement Bulletin Board for 7 calendar days (Annex A - ITB);

WHEREAS, a pre-bidding conference was held on 23 November 2022 and attended by the BAC Members, BAC Secretariat, Members of the TWG, End-users, Observers, and Prospective Bidders (Annex B - Minutes of the pre-bidding conference);

WHEREAS, in response to the above-mentioned postings, five bidders were obtained namely, **JOEBZ COMPUTER SALES AND SERVICES, AC/DC COMPONENT PART SALES & SERVICE CENTER INC., ACCESS, MEDIACAST DIGITAL GROUP INC., and ANJENE INDUSTRIES INC.**, purchased the bidding documents for ten thousand pesos (Php 10,000.00), and submitted bid proposals within the deadline of *submission and receipt of bids*, which is until 06 December 2022 at 3:00 PM;

WHEREAS, during the Bid Opening on 06 December 2022 at 9:00 AM, the BAC conducted Preliminary Examination of Bids and rated all of the bidders "passed" (Annex C - BAC Resolution for the Preliminary Examination of Bids);


WHEREAS, the BAC considered the bids/quotations of all bidders for detailed evaluation and identified the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) per item (Annex D - Bid Evaluation Report; Annex E - BAC Resolution Declaring LCB);


