BOR RESOLUTION NO. 68, s. 2019

A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE AGROSTUDIES: THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR AGRICULTURAL STUDIES IN ISRAEL, LTD. AND THE DEPLOYMENT OF THIRTEEN (13) BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN AGRICULTURE (BSA) STUDENTS TO UNDERTAKE THEIR ON-THE-JOB TRAINING (OJT) UNDER THE AGROSTUDIES INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN ISRAEL, BATCH 2019-2020

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power “to develop consortia and other forms of linkages with local government units, institutions and agencies, both public and private, local and foreign, in furtherance of the purposes and objectives of the University” as stipulated in Item (s), Section 7 of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power “to enact rules and regulations, not contrary to law, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the University” as stipulated in Section 7, Paragraph (a) of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, the CHED Memorandum Order No. 22, s. 2013 provides the general policies and guidelines related to the fielding of students for internship;

WHEREAS, the University Administration finds it advantageous to undertake linkage with various public and private institutions and entities to further promote the objectives and program thrusts of the University and in the process help prepare its students find gainful employment after graduation;

WHEREAS, the Department of Horticulture, College of Agriculture, VSU Main Campus has endorsed thirteen (13) students to undertake their On-The-Job Training (OJT) in Israel through the Agrostudies Program, as follows:


