## BOR RESOLUTION NO. 62, s. 2008

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CHANGE OF COLLEGE NAME OF THE VSU ISABEL CAMPUS FROM COLLEGE OF INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY(CIT) TO COLLEGE OF INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY AND ENGINERING (CITE)

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power "to establish and absorb non-chartered institutions within the Province of Leyte as brances, centers, stations, etc., in coordination with the CHED and in consultation with the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and to offer therein. Programs or courses to promote and carry out equal access to educational opportunities managed by the Constitution" as stipulated in Item (1), Section 7 of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, the VSU Isabel Campus then known as Isabel National Agricultural and Vocational School (INAVS) was integrated with the VSU way back in 1999 and subsequently had renamed as College of Industrial Technology (CIT);

WHEREAS, in accordance with the University's Strategic Plan, the Isabel Campus has been designated by the Engineering hub of the University;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to reflect this new mandate by changing the name of the College from college of Industrial Technology (CIT) to College of Industrial Technology and Engineering (CITE);

**WHEREAS**, the University Administrative Council unanimously approved the change in name of the College during the 72<sup>nd</sup> UADCO Meeting held last 19 September at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the Center for Continuing Education, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the change in name of the College of Industrial Tachnology (CIT) of the VSU-Isabel Campus to College of Industrial Technology and Engineering effective upon Board approval.
