APPROVING THE INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL OF SIX (6) STUDENTS OF VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY TO PARTICIPATE IN IMMERSION/SYMPOSIUM/TRAINING PROGRAM ON THE DATE, VENUE AND PURPOSE OF TRAVEL AS PRESENTED, THE DETAILS OF WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE DOCUMENTS HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE PART HEREOF

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to *"exercise all the powers granted to the Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68 otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines"*;

WHEREAS, VSU is a CHED Center for Excellence (COE) in Agriculture and a National University in Region VIII, it is mandated to provide leadership in developing highly competitive human resource, relevant scientific knowledge, and innovative technologies to support the sustainable development of the Visayas Region in particular and the whole of the Philippines in general;

WHEREAS, the essence of the proposal was to request for BOR approval on the proposed foreign travels of some students as part of their student development and further request the BOR to authorize the University President to issue Travel Authority to the students;

WHEREAS, the conferences, seminars, and related activities have been certified by International Affairs Service (IAS) of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) as legitimate and bona fide;

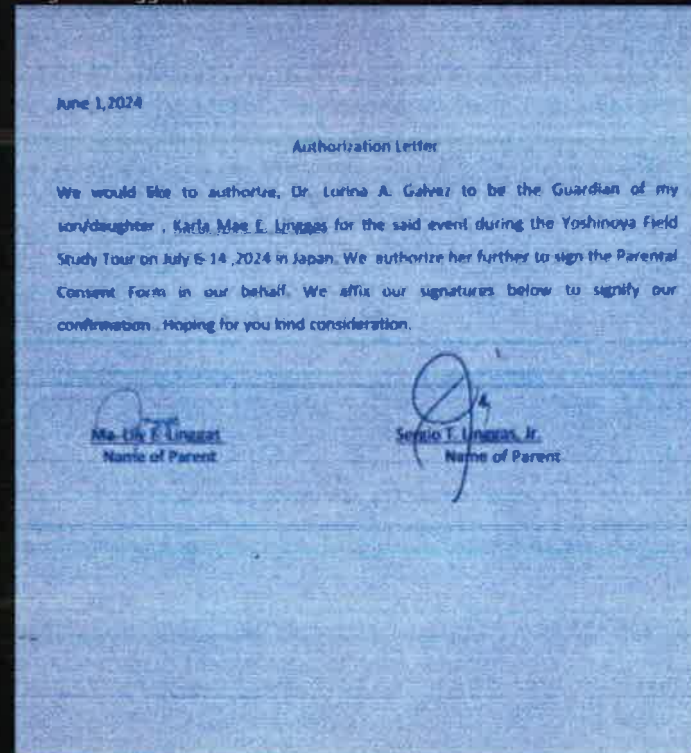

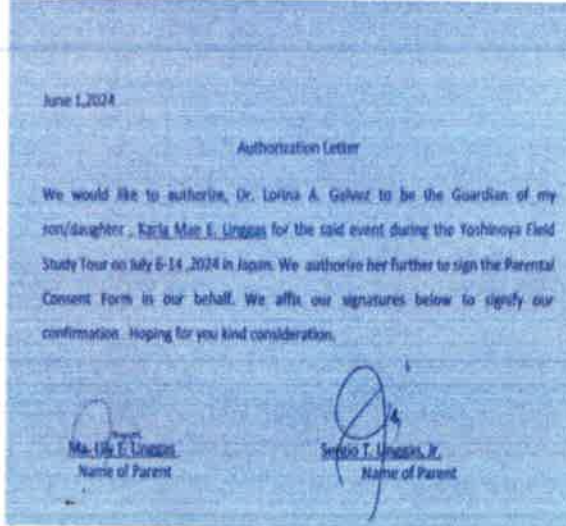



What SOCIAL ISSUE AFFECTS YOU PERSONALLY?

Academic overload, underfunding of the Philippine education sector, and poor educational outcomes – these are three distinct factors that, in my view, render the Philippine educational system ineffective and unproductive. Consequently, the social issue that affects me personally is the substandard educational system in the Philippines.

As a Filipino student within the Philippine educational system, I typically invested 8-10 hours daily in schooling, particularly throughout my grade school to high school years. This workload results in excessive time spent in school and an overwhelming influx of academic information daily. According to neuroscientist Daniel J. Levitin, this cognitive overload can induce significant psychological strain on the brain, ultimately diminishing students' productivity.

In regard to the gross domestic product (GDP), the Philippines allocates only 3% to its education sector, falling short of the United Nations' recommended minimum allocation of 6%. This underfunding can significantly impact the quality of education offered. Moreover, according to the World Bank, more than 80 percent of Filipino children do not know what they should know in school.

There is a multitude of aspects that deteriorates the educational system of the Philippines, evident in its declining performance. I believe that by reducing school hours, meeting the UN standards for education funding in the Philippines, and enhancing educational outcomes, we can establish and maintain an effective and productive educational system for Filipino citizens.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO PROMOTE POSITIVE SOCIAL CHANGE?

Fostering advocacies and spearheading initiatives are something that I am deeply passionate about. Especially when cultivating the well-being of the Filipinos, I can work tirelessly in championing a more inclusive and flourishing community.

As a determined young student leader, the best way I can promote positive social change is through volunteering. I am prepared to dedicate my skills and time to uphold initiatives and support organizations addressing social needs. This includes participating in feeding and tutorial programs for underprivileged children and actively engaging to environmental clean-up initiatives.

With over a decade of active involvement in diverse organizational endeavors, I have cultivated proficiency in fostering collaboration and nurturing partnerships. Leveraging these skills, I am confident in driving positive social change through effective collaboration and partnership with other organizations and individuals who have the same vision as I do.

The AAACU study tour for students of agriculture is back on the road!

The COVID-19 pandemic has put the annual study tour in 2020 to a halt. In 2021, as knowledge and control over the pandemic started to improve, AAACU was able to conduct the very first online study tour through the able support of Nagoya University in Japan which has designed and developed a successful virtual program.
