

PROPOSAL TO CHANGE THE GRADING SYSTEM
OF LSU LABORATORY HIGH SCHOOL

RATIONALE:

The LSU Laboratory High School has been implementing a Grading System in which the Highest Rating is 95% and the Lowest is 65%. At present more high schools even the DECS are adopting a grading system with the Highest Rating of 100% and the Lowest Rating of 70%.

To make our students more competitive with students from other schools in getting scholarship opportunities, to give deserving students the appropriate grades due them, and to keep abreast of the trend of the time, we propose the following revision of the LSU Laboratory High School Grading System.
