A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH A REFERENDUM AUTHORIZING PRESIDENT, DR. JOSE L. BACUSMO, TO DESIGNATE DR. EDGARDO E. TULIN, VP FOR INSTRUCTION AS OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF THE UNIVERITY FOR THE DURATION OF THE PRESIDENT'S OFFICIAL TRAVEL TO INDIA SUBJECT TO EXISTING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING POWERS THAT MAY BE EXERCISED BY AN OFFICER-IN-CHARGE

WHEREAS, the International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT) has an active collaboration with the Department of Agriculture (DA), Local Government Units (LGUs), and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs);

WHEREAS, the ICRISAT has invited the University President, Dr. Jose L. Bacusmo, to ICRISAT Headquarters in Patancheru, Telangana, India this coming 14-18 Sepember 2014 for a Scientific Exposure/Visit;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the University President to designate an Officer-In-Charge (OIC) to look after the day-to-day operations including making routine but necessary decisions so as not to unduly delay any and all operations of the University; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin, Vice-President for Instruction, has been designated by the University President, Dr. Jose L. Bacusmo, to be the Officer-In-Charge of the University for the duration of his official travel to India from 14 September 2014 to 18 September 2014 or until his return to the University Main Campus.

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Dr. Jose L. Bacusmo, University President, be authorized to designate Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin as Officer-In-Charge of the University for the duration of the President's official travel to ICRISAT Headquarters, Patancheru, Telangana, India this coming 14–18 September 2014.
