




MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

LEYTE STATE UNIVERSITY

and

PAMPANGA AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **Understanding**, made and executed by and between:

LEYTE STATE UNIVERSITY (LSU), a state institution of higher learning duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines with principal place of business at Baybay, Leyte, represented herein by its President, **DR. PACENCIA P. MILAN**,

and

PAMPANGA AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE (PAC), a state institution of higher learning duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines with principal place of business at Magalang, Pampanga, represented herein by its President, **DR. ZOSIMO M. BATTAD**.

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS, both **LSU** and **PAC** has commodity responsibilities for research and development, and has generated information and technologies that are considered relevant to rural development;

WHEREAS, **LSU** and **PAC** are both mandated with the responsibility of developing scientific, technological, and vocational efficiency in their respective regions and of contributing to accelerate national and economic development through research, extension, training and agribusiness programs;

WHEREAS, both parties hereto mutually agree to make joint and complementary efforts in order that **LSU** and **PAC** can achieve more effective contributions to countryside development as well as agricultural and fishery modernization especially in the production enhancement of the various commodities, development and promotion through appropriate technology transfer and commercialization approaches and strategies.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the covenants set forth herein, the parties agree to pursue collaborative effort under the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES

This **Understanding** establishes the general basis necessary to accomplish the following objectives:

- a. To collaborate in research, extension, training and agribusiness ventures as well as in the development and promotion of viable technologies and management strategies that will help improve productivity and income level of the rural people with great concern on conserving natural resources;
- b. To provide mechanism for exchange of scientific information, technologies and expertise which will enhance educational excellence and performance of both parties; and,
- c. To provide a framework and legal foundation for future specific operational Understanding for cooperation, whether they arise from shared concern, or on proposal for collaboration from either party.

ARTICLE 2: AREAS OF COOPERATION

The areas of cooperation under this **Understanding** include those within the broad range of functions carried out by both parties, specifically, but not limited to:

- a. Collaborative research on agriculture, fisheries, forestry, natural resources as well as culture and arts projects of mutual interest to both parties;
- b. Exchange of information and instructional/training materials such as, but not limited to manuals, slide films, videos, brochures and research outputs;
- c. Co-sponsoring training courses, workshops and other activities on areas or disciplines where both parties have uniqueness and strengths; and,
- d. Any other areas of concern that the parties may deem appropriate.

ARTICLE 3: IMPLEMENTATION

The parties shall observe the following guidelines in implementing this **Understanding** whenever possible or appropriate:

- a. Official contact and detailed implementation plan between **LSU** and **PAC** shall be maintained through the officers designated by each institution for the purpose of this **Understanding**;

- b. The operation of the **Understanding** shall take place through specific accords on concrete projects indicating the objectives, instruments, form of participation and contributions of each of the parties; and,
- c. These accords may be formalized with other bilateral or multilateral agencies of technical cooperation or financial assistance, when the signatories to this **Understanding** deem it appropriate.

ARTICLE 4: AMENDMENTS

The terms of this **Understanding** may be modified or amended with the concurrence of both parties and that such modification or amendment shall be made in the form of ADDENDA attached to this **Understanding**.

ARTICLE 5: DURATION

This **Understanding** shall take effect on the date it is signed by both parties and shall have duration of **five (5) years**, without prejudice for renewal, unless one of the parties shall elect to terminate this **Understanding**. Provided that such official notice shall be rendered in no less than one (1) month in advance, subject to mutual agreement on pertinent obligations related with any on-going project at the time of notice.
