BOR RESOLUTION NO. 2, s. 2015

**A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE
ADDITIONAL FACULTY MEMBERS PROMOTED TO HIGHER POSITIONS
THROUGH NBC 461 – 5th CYCLE AND ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE PASUC AND
DBM FOR FUNDING IN CY 2015 and CY 2016**

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of RA 9158 provides: *“The Board shall have the following specific powers and duties in addition to its general power of administration and the exercise of the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of the Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporation Code of the Philippines”*;

WHEREAS, Paragraph (h) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board *“to fix and adjust salaries of faculty members and administrative officials and employees subject to the provisions of the Revised Compensation and Position Classification System and other pertinent budget and compensation laws governing hours of service, and such other duties and conditions as it may deem proper; ...”*

WHEREAS, during the PASUC TWG meeting held last 04 March 2015 at the Century Park Sheraton Hotel, Mr. Dante Alumno of the DBM Central Office informed the “Body” that out of the P1.3 billion allocated for NBC 461 implementation up to the 5th Cycle, there is still a balance of P288 million after receiving all the data from PASUC and the DBM”;

WHEREAS, Mr. Alumno indicated that “the money should be allocated to the SUCs as DBM is no longer allowed to put in a lump sum fund for later requests (the MPBF is already deemed abolished)”;

WHEREAS, Mr. Alumno requested SUCs through PASUC to “submit the remaining requirements to implement NBC 461 up to the 6th Cycle giving March 6 as the deadline for submission to PASUC and until Tuesday for inclusion in the eGMIS of the DBM (meaning NOSCA already issued by DBM Regional Offices”;


WHEREAS, the faculty members were not included in the past BOR Resolution approving their promotion since some of them had not yet been fully accredited as “full-professors”;


WHEREAS, the University President is strongly endorsing the request to the VSU Board of Regents for Approval by Referendum *Subject to* existing rules, regulations and guidelines governing such appointments.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to Approve the Additional List of Faculty Members Promoted to Higher Positions through NBC 461 – 5th Cycle and Endorsing the same to the PASUC and the DBM for Funding in CY 2015 and CY 2016.







I would like to inform your good Office that there are some very urgent matters that require immediate BOR action.

First, I was just informed by the University President that tomorrow is the deadline imposed by the Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges (PASUC) for the submission of list of additional faculty members upgraded through NBC 461 – 5th Cycle for funding by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) for CY 2015 and CY 2016 as contained in a PASUC Advisory dated 19 February 2015.

Second, the Hohenheim University and the Nature-Life International, Stuttgart, Germany is donating books and Compact Disks to the Visayas State University Main Campus and that these are already in transit through airfreight carrier DHL. The BOR Resolution is urgently needed to waive any and all Customs duties that may be imposed when these materials are landed in Mactan, Cebu, Philippines.

Madam Chair, on behalf of the University, I would like to request that these two very urgent requests be approved by the VSU Board of Regents by way of Referendum, for reasons of extreme urgency.





UNTIL CUT-OFF YEAR 2013**

Date : February 19, 2015

In anticipation of any unused amount from the 1.3 Billion fund allotted to fund the implementation of the NBC 461 up to the 5th cycle promotions (cut off: June 30, 2010), SUCs may proceed with the evaluation for the 6th cycle covering the period July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013. SUCs who can submit to PASUC Office any or all of the following on or before February 28, 2015 may have a chance of being funded this year, to wit:

1. Notice of Organization, Staffing and Compensation Action (NOSCA) issued by DBM regional Offices;
2. Plantilla for implementation with official print-out duly released by the NBC 461 Zonal Centers in relation to the NBC 461 6th Cycle evaluation.

Allocation of any unused amount for the funding of NBC 461 6th cycle promotions for CY 2015 will be on a "first come first serve basis". Formal communication will be sent to SUCs after confirmation by DBM.

SUCs who may not meet the above deadline may continue with the evaluation for possible funding in 2016 and beyond.

The Zonal Centers are hereby advised to accommodate the processing of evaluation results and release appropriate print-outs accordingly.
