the Bid for BAC2-GOODS-18-23, Awarded to BNC Industrial Products Enterprises and
to Recommend the Rebidding of the Supplies and Materials**

WHEREAS, BAC 2 recommended BAC Resolution No 24 Series of 2018 that BNC won in a bidding done in 10 October 2018, to Supply and Deliver Construction, electrical, fire Protection Materials and Supplies VSU Main Campus and External Campuses (BAC2-GOODS-18-23);

WHEREAS, the total value or the ABC for this award is Two Million Eighty-One Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven and 91/100 Pesos (Php 2,081,287.91);

WHEREAS, on 10 December 2018, the BAC2, sent a Notice of Award to BNC Industrial Products Enterprises whose General Manager/Proprietor is Mr. Butch G. Cabintoy;

WHEREAS, no attempt to sign the Notice of Award or response regarding such Award from BNC Industrial Product Enterprises was received;

WHEREAS, on 28 February 2019, Mr. Butch Cabintoy wrote a letter indicating that they may no longer deliver the goods as they failed to consider the cost on the lot bases, and not on per item;

WHEREAS, on 7 March 2019, BAC 2 sent a SHOW CAUSE ORDER to Mr. Butch Cabintoy for failure to complete his bid offer and he failed to respond accordingly;

WHEREAS, the list of Purchase Request Number, Project Titles and Signatories of the Purchase Request is still intact, thus tracking back the original Purchase Request can be done and a re-processing of the Purchase Request should accommodate the inflation of prices of goods;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to declare this part of the bidding to have failed, so as to continue the process of procurement;


NOW, THEREFORE, based on the above premises, we the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, **HEREBY RESOLVE**, as it is **RESOLVED** to:


1. Recommend to the HOPE to declare a failure of bidding for this portion of the bid;
