APPROVING THE PROPOSED REVISIONS ON THE GUIDELINES OF THE SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATION AWARD OF THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY, THEREBY AMENDING ALL PREVIOUS BOARD RESOLUTIONS AND UNIVERSITY ISSUANCES WHICH MAY BE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, THE DETAILS OF WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE DOCUMENT HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE PART HEREOF

WHEREAS, under Section 4 (a) of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997," the VSU Board of Regents is empowered to enact rules and regulations not contrary to law as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the university or college;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 9158, the University's enabling law, declares it a policy of the State to strengthen higher education institutions as centers of excellence and development in instruction, research, and extension;

WHEREAS, the Board of Regents, through Resolution No. 121, series of 2023, initially approved the establishment of the Scientific Publication Award to recognize and incentivize faculty and researchers for publishing in reputable scientific journals;

WHEREAS, subsequent revisions and enhancements to the award guidelines were approved through BOR Resolution No. 161, series of 2024, to align with updated academic standards and the university management's commitment to quality by streamlining the evaluation process and in the proper use of government funds;

WHEREAS, the proposed revisions of the Scientific Publication Award are presented to the Governing Board: details of which are presented and discussed in Annex "AA" and made part of this resolution;

WHEREAS, the proposal has been thoroughly reviewed and evaluated by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) at the March 10, 2025, meeting and recommended for approval;

WHEREAS, finding the recommendation in order, the Governing Board agreed to approve the proposed revisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion, duly seconded, and unanimously approved, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Regents of Visayas State University approves the proposed revisions on the guidelines of the Scientific Publication Award of the Visayas State University, thereby amending all previous board resolutions and university issuances which may be inconsistent herewith, the details of which are reflected in the document hereto attached and made part hereof.

If the applicant is not the primary or corresponding author, the co-author applicant must have clearly indicated his/her contribution in the publication following the CRediT (Contributor Roles Taxonomy) author statement. The same will apply for SPA-Books.
