BOR RESOLUTION NO. 110

Series of 2024

APPROVING THE RELEASE OF 2024 SUMMER BILLING AND GRADUATION FEES RELATED TO THE FOR ISSUANCE OF SARO AS PART OF THE GAA 2024 UNDER THE PROJECT "FREE HIGHER EDUCATION" AND THE APPROVAL OF ITS PROGRAM OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES (PRE), FURTHER DETAILS OF WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE DOCUMENT HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE PART HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Paragraph (b), Section 7 of R.A. 9158 provides: "To receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University";

WHEREAS, the FHE shall support the cost of tertiary education or any portion thereof for all Filipino students who are enrolled at the time of the effectivity of the Act in courses leading to a bachelor's degree in the University per Section 4 of the IRR of RA 10931;

WHEREAS, the FHE billing is under For Later Release as incorporated in the 2024 GAA amounting to P149,759,000.00 for CY 2024, under the program Implementation of Free Higher Education;

WHEREAS, VSU requested BOR approval for FHE billing based on actual enrolment for Ten Million Three Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Pesos (P10,336,888.00), under the program Implementation of Free Higher Education;

WHEREAS, the details for the 2024 summer billing and graduation fees are allocated to different items as reflected in the details below;

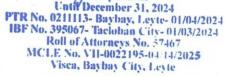
