## BOR RESOLUTION NO. 28, s. 2015

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REVISED VSU HOUSING CONTRACT EFFECTIVE UPON APPROVAL BY THE VSU BOARD OF REGENTS AND SUBJECT TO RENEWAL EVERY THREE (3) YEARS

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of R.A. 9158 specifically provides that the University "shall have the general powers of a corporation as set forth in the Corporation Law. The Administration of the University and the exercise of its powers shall be vested exclusively in the Board of Regents";

WHEREAS, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power "to enact rules and regulations, not contrary to law, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the University" as stipulated in Section 7, Paragraph (a) of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, the Visayas State University is one of very few State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) in the Philippines providing in-campus housing for its employees and that many academic and administrative personnel have enjoyed or enjoying this privilege;

WHEREAS, the University levies a Housing Maintenance Fee on the lessees/occupants of these housing units since the General Appropriations Act (GAA) does not include a budgetary allocation for the maintenance of the University's housing facilities;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to revise and upgrade the University Housing Contract since its last revision through the passage of BOR Resolution No. 25, s. 2005 dated 05 February 2005;

WHEREAS, the revised University Housing Contract was approved by the University Administrative Council during its 98<sup>th</sup> UADCO Meeting dated 13 November 2012;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board, requested the Board Secretary to integrate all BOR Resolutions pertaining to University Housing and in this instance, is convinced that the revised VSU Housing Contract is sound and will redound to the benefit of the University and the lessees of the housing units.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the proposed revision of the VSU Housing Contract effective upon BOR approval and all other provisions on University Housing inconsistent with the provisions contained therein are effectively repealed.
