#### BOR RESOLUTION NO. 21, s. 2012

#### A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSAL TO REQUIRE "CONSENT OF PROFESSOR" ONLY IN ALL CHEMISTRY SUBJECTS IN THE MASTER OF EDUCATION (MEd) PROGRAM MAJOR IN CHEMISTRY EFFECTIVE 1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER SY 2012-2013

WHEREAS, the Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) was converted into the Leyte State University (LSU) by virtue of Republic Act 9158 last 11 August 2001 and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6, of R.A. 9158 stipulates, to wit: "The Board shall promulgate policies in accordance with the declared State policies on education and other pertinent provisions of the Constitution on education, agriculture, science and technology, as well as the policies, standards and thrusts of the CHED under Republic Act No. 7722";

WHEREAS, the Board of Regents approved in 2008 that all Chemistry courses in the MEd *major* in Chemistry shall have a "Consent of Instructor" as prerequisite, except for CHEM 209 which had CHEM 202 as prerequisite;

WHEREAS, the Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry has decided to re-sequence its course offerings such that the course CHEM 207 (formerly CHEM 202) – Chemical Structure and Reactivity – is now be taken before CHEM 209, thus there should no longer be any prerequisite required for CHEM 209;

**WHEREAS**, Section 11 of R.A. 9158 stipulates that it is the duty of the Academic Council "...to review and recommend curricular offerings and fix the requirements for the admission to the University, as well as for graduation and the conferment of degrees, subject to the approval of the Board...";

WHEREAS, the proposal was presented and approved during the 30<sup>th</sup> University Academic Council (UAC) Meeting held last 27 February 2012 at the University Convention Center, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte and is strongly endorsing the proposal for **Approval** by the VSU Board of Regents.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to approve the Proposal to Require "Consent of Professor" Only in all Chemistry subjects in the Master of Education (MEd) Program major in Chemistry, effective 1<sup>st</sup> Semester, SY 2012-2013.
