BOR RESOLUTION NO. 57, s. 2014

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ABOLITION OF 14 VACANT HIGHER FACULTY POSITIONS TO CREATE 28 INSTRUCTOR I POSITIONS *PROVIDED* THAT THE NUMBER OF INSTRUCTOR I POSITIONS CREATED SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS ABOLISHED AND *PROVIDED FURTHER* THAT, THE EXTERNAL CAMPUSES SHALL BE GIVEN AN EQUITABLE NUMBER OF INSTRUCTOR I POSITIONS COMMENSURATE TO THE VALUE OF THE HIGH-LEVEL POSITIONS GIVEN UP AND FINALLY, *SUBJECT TO* EXISTING POLICIES, RULES AND GUIDELINES ON THIS MATTER

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to “*exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines*”;

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (a) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board “*to enact rules and regulations, not contrary to law, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the University*”;

WHEREAS, the University has a few high-level academic positions which have become vacant as a consequence of the retirement of academic faculty holding these positions;

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) has advised all government agencies that budgetary allocation for unfilled positions will only be released once these are filled-up;

WHEREAS, the VSU Human Resource Management Office has ascertained that with the present manpower complement of the VSU, these high-level positions cannot be filled-up due to lack of qualified candidates;

WHEREAS, the VSU Human Resource Management Office has proposed to the DBM for the conversion of 14 high-level academic positions to 28 Instructor I positions following the usual 1:1 “scrap and build” policy of the DBM;


WHEREAS, the Academic Personnel Board has gone over the proposal during its 14 July 2014 meeting and has recommended the abolition of the aforementioned high-level academic positions in exchange for Instructor I positions;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the abolition of the 14 high-level academic positions, as proposed, *Provided That*, the number of Instructor I positions created shall not be less than the number of positions abolished and *Provided Further*, That, the External Campuses will be given an equitable number of Instructor I positions commensurate to the high-level positions they have given-up.


