Proposal to Grant Free Tuition Fees to Incoming Freshmen for the BSA and BAS Degree Programs

Board Resolution No. 3, s. 2005

Approving the proposal to grant free tuition fee to 40 incoming freshmen students pursuing the degree of Bachelor of Science in Agriculture (BSA) and Bachelor of Animal Science (BAS) effective 1st Semester, SY 2005-2006, <u>Provided, that</u> a Grantee who stops and transfers to another school will be assessed and made to pay the equivalent amount of tuition fee enjoyed earlier and <u>Provided Further, that</u> a study of this provision will be made after one year of implementation.

PROPOSAL TO GRANT FREE TUITION FEES TO INCOMING FRESHMEN FOR THE BSA AND BAS DEGREE PROGRAMS

(As approved by the Board of Regents per BOR Resolution No. 3, s. 2005, dated 16 February 2005)

Implementing Guidelines*

- 1. Grantee must have an average grade of 85% or higher upon graduation in High School (Certification from the principal must accompany the student's report card upon application along with other pertinent requirements for entering freshmen).
- Valedictorians and Salutatorians who are already granted honorific scholarship but opt/decide to be in program shall be accommodated upon submission of certification and other pertinent documents from the principal or his duly authorized representative.
- 3. **Grantee must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or better** for continuity of the grant. Students who at the start did not qualify, will be granted the privilege as soon as the average grade requirement (exclusive of NSTP/PE) of 2.0 or better is obtained.
- 4. Grantee must not be a recipient of another scholarship grant. Students enjoying other scholarship/grant but opt for this program must execute a waiver indicating his/her preference for the latter.
- 5. Entering freshmen who may enjoy the free tuition free privilege as son/daughter of faculty and staff may be given an equivalent discount from the laboratory fee. In no instance, however, that such a discount should exceed the total amount for tuition fees.
- 6. Grantee must complete the BSA or BAS degree programs within the prescribed period of four years. Grant automatically ceases when grantee fails to complete the program within the prescribed period.
- 7. Grantee who stops and transfer to another school for reasons other than ill-health without completing the degree program will be assessed and made to pay the equivalent amount of tuition fee enjoyed earlier. Release of transfer credentials or approval of shifting permits will be made only upon full payment of such and other accountabilities.
- 8. Scholarship Contract should be made to be signed by LSU and the student.
