APPROVING THE REVISED COMPUTATION FORMULA FOR THE RELATED LEARNING EXPERIENCE (RLE) COMPONENT OF THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING PROGRAM OF THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY, AS DESCRIBED IN THE DOCUMENT ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE PART HEREOF, THEREBY AMENDING ALL PREVIOUS BOARD RESOLUTIONS AND UNIVERSITY ISSUANCES WHICH MAY BE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, Section 4 (i) Republic Act No. 8292, also known as the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997", provides the framework for SUC governance and establishes the powers of the SUC's governing board, including the authority to approve the curricula, institutional programs and rules of discipline drawn by the administrative and academic council:

WHEREAS, in its commitment to providing the students with comprehensive and highquality clinical education, the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at Visayas State University proposed to amend the computation formula for the Related Learning Experience (RLE) fees;

WHEREAS, the increasing student population and the consequent hiring of affiliate clinical instructors and laboratory aides necessitate a revision of the formula stipulated in BOR Resolution No. 41, series of 2009;

WHEREAS, the proposal highlights changes in (1) Enhanced Categorization of Fee Components: i. School Payment, ii. Affiliation Fee for Hospitals or Health Centers, iii. Payment for Affiliate Clinical Instructors (Cls), iv. Laboratory Aide Payment, and (2) Simplified Computation Based on RLE Course Units;

WHEREAS, the proposal promotes a more equitable, reflective, and efficient system for calculating RLE fees, benefitting both students and the university by promoting financial transparency and accuracy;

WHEREAS, the proposal has been thoroughly evaluated by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) at the February 14, 2025, meeting and obtained favorable endorsement;

WHEREAS, Regent Bulayog raised the possibility that RLE fees be included among those charged to the government. Chairperson Valenzuela responded that the Board cannot act on the suggestion, noting that the RLE component is not covered under the Free Higher Education Act, and further recommended deputizing a team to study the matter further;

WHEREAS, finding the recommendation in order, the Governing Board agreed to approve the proposal to revise the computation formula for the RLE fees:

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I. TITLE

Proposal to Amend the Related Learning Experience (RLE) Fee Computation Formula for BS Nursing Students

II. PROPONENT

Faculty of Nursing

III. RATIONALE

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at Visayas State University is committed to providing its students with comprehensive and high-quality clinical education. This is achieved through the Related Learning Experience (RLE) component, composed of skills laboratory and clinical rotation, which plays a pivotal role by providing them with skills acquisition in a controlled skills laboratory setting and practical exposure to real-world clinical settings through clinical rotations, aligning with the standards of professional nursing practice.

Currently, the allocation of RLE fees is based on BOR Resolution No. 41 s. 2009. It requires revision to reflect the actual costs that need to be paid using the RLE Fee funds. The growing number of students and hiring of affiliate clinical instructors and laboratory aide necessitate sufficient resources to cover the costs related to these. Furthermore, portions of the existing computation formula (such as the 50% administrative cost which was imposed twice) are deemed unnecessary. Hence, this proposal.

This proposal aims to create a more equitable, reflective, and efficient system for calculating RLE fees, benefiting both students and the institution by promoting financial transparency and accuracy.

IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

Affiliate Clinical Instructors – nurses who are employed in private hospitals hired by VSU through the Faculty of Nursing to serve as preceptors of BSN students during clinical rotation and are paid on an hourly basis

Affiliate institution – an identified hospital, maternity clinic, or community where BSN students conduct clinical rotations

Affiliation Fee – an amount required by affiliate institutions per BSN student during clinical rotation

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Clinical Rotation - the act of proceeding to an affiliate institution to render hospital or community duty

Group – refers to a certain number of students (8-12) sent to the affiliate institution for clinical rotation

Laboratory Aide – hired personnel by FON to perform the functions relative to maintaining the operations and functionality of the FON Skills Laboratory

Related Learning Experience (RLE) - composed of Clinical Duty and Skills Laboratory, these are activities carefully selected to develop competencies utilizing the nursing process in varying health situations

Related Learning Experience (RLE) Day - refers to eight (8) hours of clinical rotation rendered

Related Learning Experience (RLE) Fee – an amount collected by the Faculty of Nursing through the University Cashier from BSN students to cover the administrative costs of maintaining and operating the FON Skills Laboratory, affiliation fee, salary of affiliate instructors and salary of the FON Laboratory Aide

Student - refers to BSN students enrolled in the Academic Year/Semester being referred to

Unit – refers to the academic credit hours of courses enrolled by the BSN student, computed as 18 hours per 1 lecture and 51 hours per 1 RLE unit

V. HIGHLIGHTS AND SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

- 1. Enhanced Categorization of Fee Components:
 - a. Previous Structure: The RLE fee structure previously consisted of only two broad categories. This limited scope did not reflect the actual range of costs associated with Related Learning Experience activities.
 - b. **New Structure**: The proposed adjustment introduces a comprehensive breakdown into **four distinct categories**, ensuring a more transparent and detailed allocation of fees. These categories are:
 - School Payment: Covers general administrative and instructional expenses related to facilitating RLE programs, including the use of university resources and support services.
 - ii. Affiliation Fee for Hospitals or Health Centers: Allocated for partnerships with external medical facilities that provide essential clinical training environments.
 - iii. Payment for Affiliate Clinical Instructors (CIs): Ensures compensation for the specialized expertise of affiliate CIs, who play a crucial role in guiding students during hands-on practice in clinical settings.
 - iv. Laboratory Aide Payment: Allocated for the support provided by lab aides who assist in the preparation, maintenance, and management of equipment and resources necessary for practical learning sessions.

This multi-tiered structure offers clearer visibility into where student fees are directed and provides accountability for the various entities involved in the delivery of the RLE program.

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2. Simplified Computation Based on RLE Course Units:

- a. The fee computation methodology has been refined to align directly with the number of units for which a student is enrolled in RLE courses. This change simplifies the process by creating a proportional fee structure, where students only pay according to the actual load of their RLE coursework.
- b. This adjustment ensures that students are charged fairly, reflecting the intensity and duration of their enrolled courses, and supports more efficient financial planning for both the students and the institution.

WHEREAS, the University has just started offering the ladderized Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) in SY 2007-2008;

WHEREAS, the said ladderized BSN program is a competency-based and community-oriented curriculum;

WHEREAS, all BSN students have to take Related Nursing Experience (RLE) in order to comply with TEDSA requirements prior to the award of the degree;

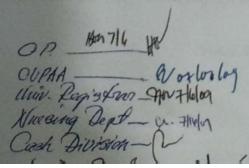
WHEREAS, the all BSN students are required to undertake 153 RLE hours in the First Year, 714 RLE hours in the Second Year, 816 RLE hours in the Third Year and 816 RLE hours in the Fourth Year for a total of 2,499 RLE hours for the whole BSN program per CHED Memorandum Order No. 5, s. 2008;

WHEREAS, ten (10) students undertaking their RLE will be supervised by one (1) clinical instructor who will be remunerated at the rate of P100.00 per hour such that each BSN student will be assessed an RLE Fee of P10.00/hour for all RLE subjects in the BSN curriculum;

WHEREAS, the University Administrative Council discussed and approved the proposed Related Learning Experience fee of P10.00 per hour per student for all RLE subjects in accordance with CHED Memoranda on this matter.

THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the proposed Related Learning Experience fee of P10.00 per hour per student for all RLE subjects in accordance with CHED Memoranda on this matter, effective 1st Semester SY 2009-2010.

PROPOSAL FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF RELATED LEARNING EXPERIENCE (RLE) FEE FOR BSN STUDENTS

Rationale

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) curriculum is a competency-based and community-oriented curriculum. The teaching-learning process is best achieved by the proper selection and organization of learning experiences in a given situation. Hence, the challenges depend greatly in the preparedness and ability of the faculty to organize the learning experiences in the classroom or various health situations based on the clearly-defined objectives.

The RLE are viewed in terms of changes in the behavior of the students and not just in terms of content. The faculty must be competent in selecting RLE that will provide for continuity, sequence and integration of principles, concepts, skills and values that have been previously learned in the classroom and other situations.

When VSU offered BSN in June 2007, the tuition fee per student was fixed at Php 15,000.00. This amount covers nursing and miscellaneous fees and fees for facility improvement and staff recruitment. It did not however, include RLE fee which was an integral component of the nursing education. In almost all schools offering BSN program in the country, RLE fee is separate from the tuition fees paid. It is only VSU that is not charging RLE fee. As shown in the Table I, SUC's in Region VIII are charging RLE to their students either as fixed rate or depending on the year level.

The amount of RLE fee hereby proposed with follow the CHED approved guidelines for Implementing Related Learning Experiences as follows:

Basis for computation to determine RLE fee:

RLE Fee = Number of hours assigned to faculty x hourly rate

Where:

Hourly Rate = Rate of clinical Instructor's Salary = PHP 100/hr
No. of students per group 10 students (required)

= Php 10.00/hr

PROPOSAL TO INCREASE THE RELATED LEARNING EXPERIENCE (RLE) FEE FOR BSN STUDENTS TO PAY FOR AFFILIATION FEE AND FLAT RATE SALARY OF THE CLINICAL INSTRUCTORS

I. Background

It is proposed to amend approved Board Resolution No.41 s. 2009 and adopt the new proposal for the purpose of compensating the expenses of the College of Nursing in its affiliation to the hospitals either private or public (affiliation fees) and also for the salary of the part time Clinical Instructors who will supervise the students in the Clinical area.

The new formula being proposed for the Related Learning Experience computation is benchmarked from two State Universities also offering a Nursing course. The new formula will vary in its payment depending on the number of students, number of hours on duty and number of units in a subject.

The previous formula used was:

RLE fee = number of hours assigned to faculty x hourly rate

Hourly rate = rate of Clinical Instructor's salary No. of students per group (required) = $\frac{Php \ 100/hr}{10 \ student}$ = $\frac{Php \ 10.00/hr}{10 \ student}$

• Part time Clinical Instructors are the Clinical Instructors hired specifically for the RLE duty with a flat rate salary. They are made to report for 48 hours work week (six days per week) and sometimes assist in the team teaching of the Nursing subjects if their expertise is needed but focuses in the supervision of the Related Learning Experience of the students in the Clinical area. This method encourages continuity of knowledge in the Classroom setting to the Clinical area as advocated by CMO 30 s2001 and CMO 14 s2009. It is proposed that their salary should have a flat rate of:

Php 17,000.00 /month (it is not exceeding the monthly salary of a regular faculty of a comparable rank or Instructor I)
