BOR RESOLUTION NO. 35, s. 2023

**A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING TO INCLUDE
MS. VALERIE C. VALENZONA AS ONE OF THE SIGNATORIES OF VSU FUNDS
INCLUDING MDS**

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to *“exercise all the powers granted to the Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68 otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines”*;

WHEREAS, Paragraph (b), Section 7 of R.A. 9158 provides: *“To receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University”*;

WHEREAS, VSU is a CHED Center for Excellence (COE) in Agriculture and a National University in Region VIII, it is mandated to provide leadership in developing highly competitive human resource, relevant scientific knowledge, and innovative technologies to support the sustainable development of the Visayas Region in particular and the whole of the Philippines in general;

WHEREAS, relative to the appointment of Ms. Valerie C. Valenzona as Administrative Officer I and designated as the Collecting Officer of VSU Cash Office effective February 20, 2023, it is requested that Ms. Valenzona be included as one of the signatories for all University funds including MDS that are deposited at Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP) Baybay City and Cebu Branches;

WHEREAS, the responsibility is part of Ms. Valenzona’s job as the alternate signatory of the Cash Office and is to replace Ms. Raquel H. Dohiling who is no longer assigned at the VSU Cash Office due to her promotion and transfer to the Office of the Vice President for Administration and Finance (OVPAF);

WHEREAS, the approval of the Board of Regents is absolutely necessary considering that it is part of LBP’s requirements for the updating of signatories;

WHEREAS, the VSU Administrative and Academic Committee has endorsed the proposal to the Full Board for approval during its 05 June 2023 Hybrid Meeting;

Resolved as it is thereby resolved to APPROVE the inclusion of Ms. Valenzona as one of the signatories for all University funds including MDS.
