BOR RESOLUTION NO. 119

APPROVING THE PROPOSAL TO TEMPORARILY SHELVE PROGRAMS WITH ONGOING COPC APPLICATIONS AND PHASING OUT OF DEGREES NO LONGER OFFERED IN THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS, the University shall primarily provide advanced instruction and professional training in agriculture, science and technology, education, and other related fields, undertake research and extension services, and provide progressive leadership in these areas: Provided, That the University shall ensure that it retains its original mandate as a primarily agricultural institution under Section 2 of Republic Act 9158, the university enabling law;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has the power, among others, to approve and implement policies for the university, pursuant to Section 3 of the university's enabling law;

WHEREAS, several of VSU's academic programs, both at the graduate and undergraduate levels, are not yet compliant with their respective CMOs. These programs have already been submitted for the Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC), but unfortunately, they failed to meet the requirements for the COPC award;

WHEREAS, some programs have already been revised in compliance with their respective CMOs, involving the change in the nomenclature of the program. In effect, these programs are no longer offered and do not have enrollees and the University has not reported these developments to CHED;

WHEREAS, the temporary shelving of curricular programs that have not yet obtained the COPC and the phasing out of revised programs whose nomenclature is consistent with CMOs are hereby proposed;

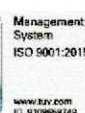
WHEREAS, the university management proposed to temporarily shelve the following programs that have not obtained program compliance but will be allowed to admit new students immediately after the COPC award;

WHEREAS, the proposal was presented in the Joint Academic and Administrative Council Meeting on September 28, 2024 and was favorably endorsed;


WHEREAS, finding the Councils' recommendation in order, the Governing Board has agreed to approve the proposal;
