WHEREAS, Section 4, Paragraph (i) of R.A. 8292 empowers the Governing Board "to approve the curricula, institutional programs and rules of discipline drawn by the administrative and academic councils, as hereby provided";

WHEREAS, the College of Forestry and Natural Resources (CFNR) of the Main Campus likewise possesses the necessary laboratory and scientific facilities including the books, journals and magazines pertaining to Environmental Management which are necessary for the successful offering of the degree program;

WHEREAS, the University Academic Council has approved by Referendum the proposed adoption of the Bachelor Science in Environmental Management (BSEM) degree program of the VSU Alanagalang Campus by the College of Forestry and Natural Resources (CFNR) of the Main Campus and has favorably recommended to the VSU Board of Regents the approval of the proposal effective 1st Semester, SY 2009-2010;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the adoption of the Bachelor Science in Environmental Management (BSEM) degree program of the VSU Alan galang Campus by the College of Forestry and Natural Resources (CFNR) of the Main Campus effective 1st Semester, SY 2009-2010.
