**A RESOLUTION
APPROVING THE ADOPTION
OF REMEDIAL MEASURES FOR 4TH YEAR BEEd
AND BSEd STUDENTS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH
CHED-PRC CIRCULAR No. 01, SERIES OF 2010 DATED 14 MAY 2010**

WHEREAS, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) issued a joint circular, CHED-PRC Circular No. 01, s. 2010 dated 14 May 2010 addressed to "All Heads of State Universities and Colleges and Local Colleges and Universities";

WHEREAS, said CHED-PRC Circular specifically declared that: "All SUCs and LCUs shall secure authority from the CHED to operate Board Programs particularly Nursing, Accountancy, Engineering, Education, and such other programs as provided in the attached list";

WHEREAS, said joint circular likewise indicated that "the PRC shall not admit applicants for licensure examination from these educational institutions which failed to comply with this circular effective January 2011";

WHEREAS, a joint CHED-PRC Monitoring and Evaluation Team visited VSU last 21-22 May 2010 and evaluated VSUs compliance of the Joint Circular *vis-à-vis* degree programs with PRC Board Examinations;

WHEREAS, said Monitoring Team has determined that the old BEEd and BSEd curricula following the old CHED Memo Order No. 11, s. 1999 require additional subjects/units in order to be fully compliant with CHED Memo Order No. 30, s. 2004;

WHEREAS, there is still one last batch of students enrolled in the old BEEd and BSEd curricula following CMO 11, s. 1999 who will be affected by the joint CHED-PRC Circular No. 1, s. 2010 and who will be barred from taking the Licensure Examination for Teachers (LET) in 2011 if they will not be able to be fully compliant with CMO 30, s. 2004;


WHEREAS, the University is obligated to offer whatever subjects as may be necessary to enable this last batch of graduating students to be fully compliant with the requirements of CMO 30, s. 2004 thus, assuring them of a chance to take the LET in 2011;


WHEREAS, Section 4, Paragraph (j) of R.A. 8292 empowers the Governing Board "*to set policies on admission and graduation of students*".

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the request of the Dean of the College of Education, VSU Main Campus, for the immediate adoption of Remedial Measures within SY 2010-2011, to the affected 4th year BEEd and BSEd students to make them fully compliant with the requirements indicated in CMO 30, s. 2004.






