## BOR RESOLUTION NO. 5 Series of 2025

APPROVING THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES OF THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY RICE PRODUCTION PROJECT, THE DETAILS OF WHICH ARE REFLECTED IN THE DOCUMENT HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE PART HEREOF

WHEREAS, under Section 4 (a) of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997, empowers the Governing Board to enact rules and regulations not contrary to law as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the university;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 9158, the University's enabling law, declares it a policy of the State to strengthen higher education institutions as centers of excellence and development in instruction, research, and extension;

WHEREAS, the proposal highlights the guidelines for (1) Qualification of the Rice Farmer Cultivator, (2) Prescribing Rice Farming Practices by the Rice Farmer Cultivator, (3) Palay Sharing Scheme between VSU and the Rice Farmer Cultivator, (4) Renewal and Termination as Rice Farmer Cultivator:

WHEREAS, the proposal has been thoroughly reviewed and evaluated by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) at the March 10, 2025, meeting and recommended for approval;

WHEREAS, finding the recommendation in order, the Governing Board agreed to approve the proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion, duly seconded, and unanimously approved, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Regents of Visayas State University approves the Implementing Guidelines of the Visayas State University, the details of which are reflected in the Annex "BB" hereto attached and made part hereof.

#### Implementing Guidelines of the VSU Rice Production Project

#### I. Qualification of the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The rice cultivator should preferably be a job order laborer or a retired employee of VSU, with a minimum of two years of experience in rice production.
- 2. The farmer cultivator should preferably be residing at the barangay or adjacent barangays where the VSU rice farm is located.
- 3. The interested farmer should submit their application to the rice production manager and await the scheduled interview before contract signing.

#### II. Prescribe Rice Farming Practices by the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The farmer cultivators should adopt the VSU rice production technology especially on the use of quality seeds of recommended variety in Region 8.
- 2. The farmer cultivators must inform VSU, through the designated production manager at least three (3) days before planting and harvesting. No harvesting shall be scheduled on a weekend or holiday.

#### III. Palay Sharing Scheme between VSU and the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- A palay sharing of 1:3 ratio taken from the gross palay yield will be followed, where VSU. as the owner of the rice production area will receive one (1) share for every 3 shares received by the rice farmer cultivator.
- 2. The cultivator must turnover to VSU its intended palay share no more and no less during harvesting.

#### IV. Renewal and Termination as Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The cultivator should inform the designated production manager of their intent to renew the contract thirty (30) days before its termination.
- 2. VSU has the right to terminate the contract if and when the rice farmer-cultivator fails to implement the prescribed VSU production technologies.
- 3. VSU has the right to terminate the contract at any time should the rice farm be needed for research, production, or construction purposes.



#### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) made and entered into by and between:

The VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY, an institution of higher learning established under Presidential Decree Number 470 as amended by the Pres. Decree no. 700 and converted into university by virtue of R.A. 9158 and 9437, with principal office at Visca, Baybay City, Leyte represented by the VSU President Dr. PROSE IVY G. YEPES hereinafter referred to as the "VSU".

and

Mr. ISIDRO FERNANDEZ of legal age, and a resident of Brgy. Pangasugan, Baybay City, Leyte hereinafter referred to as the "FARMER CULTIVATOR".

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY has an area intended for rice production under the University's Income Generating Project;

WHEREAS, these areas may be cultivated by FARMER CULTIVATORS who are rice farmers. preferably employed in VSU, and resident of the City of Baybay who willingly present himself to cultivate the VSU rice production area.

WHEREAS, this rice production area is located at VSU upper campus (near VSU Library), Baybay City, Leyte about ½ of a hectare.

# **SECTION 1: GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. This agreement shall involve the sharing of the gross palay yield in a 1:3 ratio, where VSU as the owner of the rice production area will receive one (1) share for every 3 shares received by the farmer cultivators.
- 2. The farmer cultivators are also required to inform VSU, through the designated Production Manager at three (3) days before planting and harvesting. No harvesting shall be scheduled on a weekend or holiday.
- 3. This agreement does not involve the transfer of ownership of the VSU assets and property. Ownership of the land for rice production shall remain with VSU and the cultivators are only given authority to cultivate and farm the land and are prohibited to claim, sell, lease, and or transfer its ownership to other parties.
- 4. The farmer cultivators should adopt the VSU rice production technology especially on the use of quality seeds of recommended variety in Region 8.

#### **SECTION 2: OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES**

It shall be the obligation of the VSU to:

- 1. Prepare and sign the Memorandum of Agreement.
- 2. Monitor the rice production areas of the farmer cultivator.
- 3. Be present during major activities, especially during harvesting and sharing of produce.

It shall be the obligation of the Farmer Cultivator to:

- 1. Cultivate the rice production area assigned to him/her by his/her means and capacity in accordance with the recommended rice production practices of VSU.
- 2. Inform VSU through the designated Production Manager of the schedule of the farming activities such as planting and harvesting. Harvesting should not be scheduled on a weekend or holiday.
- 3. Turnover to VSU its intended palay share no more and no less during harvesting.
- 4. Should inform the designated Production Manager of his/her intent to renew the contract thirty (30) days before its termination.

#### **SECTION 3: EFFECTIVITY and DURATION**

This MOA shall take effect upon the signing of the parties herein and shall be renewed every first month of the year. The agreement can also be terminated by either party provided notice is served two months prior to the termination date without prejudice to section 2 and 3 of this agreement.
