BOR RESOLUTION NO. 265, s. 2019

A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE REQUEST OF PROF. MANOLO B. LORETO, JR. FOR AUTHORITY TO TRAVEL TO SINGAPORE TO ATTEND THE "ASIA PACIFIC SERVICES ASSOCIATION ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION SEMINAR ON MENTAL WELLNESS IN HIGHER EDUCATION AND BENCHMARKING ON STUDENT AFFAIRS AND SERVICES" ORGANIZED BY THE ASIA PACIFIC STUDENT SERVICES ASSOCIATION (APSSA) IN SINGAPORE ON 12-13 DECEMBER 2019

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001, which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437:

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (b) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "to receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University";

WHEREAS, The Governing Board passed BOR Resolution No. 25, s. 2017 entitled: Implementing Rules and Regulations in the Availment of Financial Support from the Faculty Development Fund effective SY 2017-2018, which provides financial support to the faculty in the following activities: 1) paper presentation in local, regional, national and international professional and scientific fora; 2) participation in relevant trainings, short courses, conferences, conventions, seminars, workshops, and symposia;

WHEREAS, the Office of the CHED Chairperson issued an Unnumbered CHED Memorandum dated 24 July 2018, on the subject: <u>Guidelines in Securing Authority to Travel Abroad for State Universities and Colleges</u>;

WHEREAS, the said Unnumbered CHED Memorandum requires the following: 1) Assessment of the International Conference/Meeting issued by the International Affairs Office Staff - CHED Central Office; and 2) Board of Regents' Resolution;

WHEREAS, Prof. Manolo B. Loreto, Jr. was issued by the CHED IAS a Certification with Reference No. SUC 2019-11-193 dated 15 November 2019;

WHEREAS, Prof. Manolo B. Loreto, Jr. will be travelling to the National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technology University - Singapore and Singapore Management University to attend the Asia Pacific Services Association Roundtable Discussion on Mental Wellness in Higher Education and Benchmarking on Student Affairs and Services on 12-13 December 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to **Approve** the request of Prof. Manolo B. Loreto, Jr. for authority to travel to Singapore on 12-13 December 2019.
