OTHER MATTERS

 Proposed Utilization of P48.0 Million Capital Outlay of the Visayas State University for Calendar Year 2014

The Hon. Chair requested the University President to make a short presentation regarding this matter.

President Bacusmo informed the Board that the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issued CHED-DBM Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2014 dated 15 January 2014 otherwise known as the "Guidelines on the Allocation and Utilization of the PhP 2.5 billion Capital Outlays Pursuant to Special Provision No. 1 of the SUCs Appropriation under RA No. 10633 – the FY 2014 General Appropriations Act (GAA)".

President Bacusmo pointed out that Section 4.2 of the aforementioned Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2014, provides that the allocation shall be used exclusively for the following:

- a. Construction and/or improvement of science laboratories;
- b. Procurement of science laboratory equipment; and
- c. Other similar outlays that will enhance the learning environment in the practical application of science principles and conduct of laboratory experiments.

Further, Section 4.3 provides, to wit: "For purposes of these Guidelines, the term science shall include but not limited to natural and physical sciences, engineering and technology, agriculture, environmental science, and health sciences".

President Bacusmo explained to the Board that University is requesting for the approval of the "Proposed Utilization of P48.0 Million Capital Outlay of the Visayas State University for Calendar Year 2014" pursuant to CHED-DBM Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2014 dated 15 January 2014, broken down as follows:
