**BOR RESOLUTION NO. 07, s. 2020**

**A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE REQUEST OF MR. MICHAEL DOMINIC M. GARRIDO FOR AUTHORITY TO TRAVEL TO HIROSHIMA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN FROM 25 FEBRUARY 2020 TO 07 MARCH 2020 TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TRAINING COURSE ON MOLECULAR BIOLOGY TECHNIQUE AND BIOINFORMATICS SUBJECT TO EXISTING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING FOREIGN TRAVELS BY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS**

**WHEREAS**, the Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life, Hiroshima University will be conducting a Training Course on Molecular Biology Technique and Bioinformatics from 25 February to 07 March 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the training is part of the collaborative activities between Hiroshima University and the Visayas State University as part of the Agreement on Academic and Educational Exchange by both institutions;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Michael Dominic M. Garrido was issued with a certification by Commission on Higher Education International Affairs Staff (CHED IAS) with Reference Number SUC 2020-01-64 dated 12 February 2020;

**WHEREAS**, attendance to this conference is an opportunity for Mr. Garrido to gain significant learning and skills needed to improve his competence in instruction and research;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 (t) of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the VSU Board of Regents to *“develop academic arrangements for institutional capability building with appropriate institutions and agencies (public or private, local or foreign), and to appoint experts/specialists as consultants, or visiting or exchange professors, scholars, researchers, as the case may be;*

**WHEREAS**, the organizers have indicated that they will grant a maximum of JpY100,000 for the transport and accommodation cost of Mr. Garrido’s participation in the training course;

**WHEREAS**, the VSU Scholarship and Fellowship Committee (VSFC) is recommending approval for Mr. Garrido’s participation with allocation for local transportation and per diem;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to **Approve** the request of Mr. Michael Dominic M. Garrido for authority to travel to Hiroshima University, Japan from 25 February 2020 to 07 March 2020 to participate in the Training Course on Molecular Biology Technique and Bioinformatics, *subject to* existing rules and regulations governing foreign travels by government officials.


