**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ONE-STOREY
BUILDING FOR THE SUPPLY AND PROPERTY
OFFICE AT THE VSU ISABEL CAMPUS SUBJECT TO
EXISTING RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES**

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to "*exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines*";

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (f) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "*to authorize the construction or repair of its buildings, machineries, equipment and other facilities and the purchase and acquisition of real and personal properties, including necessary supplies, materials and equipment. Purchases and other transactions entered into by the University through the Board shall be exempt from all taxes and duties*";

WHEREAS, the Supply and Property Office (SPO) is one of the critical offices of the Isabel Campus;

WHEREAS, the smooth operations of the different operations of the College – Instruction, Research/Extension, General Administration – are dependent on the ready availability of needed supplies, materials and equipment;

WHEREAS, the SPO has never been provided with a permanent location where supplies, materials and equipment could be safely stocked;

WHEREAS, the SPO has been utilizing two (2) rooms in the Engineering Building for the past several years;

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has requested for the transfer of the SPO from its premises as it needs more classrooms for the 5th Year BS Mechanical Engineering students;

WHEREAS, the VSU Isabel Administration has recognized the need to construct a permanent structure where the SPO can be relocated and so that newly acquired supplies, materials and equipment can be safely stored;


WHEREAS, the Administration has earmarked P 1.9 million for the construction of a one-storey building for the Supply and Property Office in the Isabel Campus, Brgy Marvel, Isabel, Leyte.




