With the operationalization of the new organizational structure of the VSU system this year, our satellite campuses in Villaba, Isabel, Tolosa, Alangalang—or simply, VITA—are now Component Colleges.

With this change, the following branding and naming conventions shall be adopted.

Official Name

Campus	Full Name	Short Name
	"Visayas State University"	"VSU" or "VSU_"
Alangalang	Visayas State University Alangalang	VSU Alangalang
Isabel	Visayas State University Isabel	VSU Isabel
Tolosa	Visayas State University Tolosa	VSU Tolosa
Villaba	Visayas State University Villaba	VSU Villaba

Referencing

When referring or citing any component college aside from its formal name, either say "Component College" (recommended) or "Campus". Do not use "Satellite campus" or "External campus"; the latter sounds like an inferior reference.

Logo

The following custom logos shall be used for letterheads and for graphic publication materials. In use cases where only one round logo is required, the original VSU seal shall be used.
