**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF DR. REMBERTO A. **WHEREAS**, the University President, Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin will be travelling to Hanoi, Republic of Vietnam as an invited participant to the CIAT Asia Study Tour this coming 07 May 2017 until 11 May 2017;

**WHEREAS**, this Asia Study Visit will be an opportunity for VSU-PhilRootCrops to meet and discuss with CIAT, along with CIAT's national partners from five (5) Asian countries on current and future areas of research collaboration;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to designate an Officer-In-Charge (OIC) to look after the day-to-day operations including making routine but necessary decisions so as not to unduly delay any and all operations of the University; and

**WHEREAS**, President Edgardo E. Tulin has filed an official memorandum designating Dr. Remberto A. Patindol, Vice-President for Administration and Finance, as Officer-In-Charge of the University for the duration of his travel to Hanoi, republic of Vietnam from 07 May 2017 until 11 May 2017 or until his return to the VSU Main Campus, City of Baybay, Leyte.


