**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE
INCREASE OF ONE CREDIT UNIT OF
BASIC NURSING SKILLS LABORATORY (Nurs 102)**

WHEREAS, the University has been offering BSc. Nursing (ladderized program) since SY 2007-2008;

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) has set the competency requirements for the ladderized BSc. Nursing program and has required an additional one (1) unit laboratory equivalent to three (3) hours in the proposed Basic Nursing Skills (Nurs 102);

WHEREAS, Section 4, Paragraph (i) of R.A. 8292 empowers the Governing Board "to approve the curricula...drawn by the administrative council as hereby provided";

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Republic Act No. 8292 – The Academic Council – stipulates the powers of the Academic Council to wit: "to review and recommend the curricular offerings...of the University or college for appropriate action by the Board of Regents/Trustees...through the President of the university or college";

WHEREAS, Item a of Section 39 of CHED Memorandum No. 3, s. 2001 dated 21 January 2001 empowers the Academic Council to: "Determine, review and recommend for the approval of the Governing Board the course offerings of the concerned chartered SUC and submit the same to its GB for review and/or approval accordance with Section 4, Paragraph (i) of R.A. 8292;


WHEREAS, the University Academic Council of the Whole met last 12 February 2008 for the purpose of reviewing the proposal to increase the credit unit of Basic Nursing Skills Laboratory (Nurs 102) from 1 unit to 2 units and found the proposal to be in order and has recommended the proposal to the VSU Board of Regents for approval;


