**A RESOLUTION APPROVING
THE PROPOSED REVISION OF THE
STUDENT ADMISSION AND RETENTION POLICY
OF THE COLLEGE OF NURSING, EFFECTIVE SY 2012-2013**

WHEREAS, the Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) was converted into the Leyte State University (LSU) by virtue of Republic Act 9158 last 11 August 2001 and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, among the powers vested upon the Board of Regents is the power "*to set policies on admission and graduation of students*" as provided for Item (j), Section 7 of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, the College of Nursing of the Visayas State University has an existing Student Admission and Retention Policy which has been in place since the College was created in 2007;

WHEREAS, it is now imperative that said Student Admission and Retention policy be revisited and improved in the light of a highly changed educational landscape brought about by the global economic crisis;

WHEREAS, the College of Nursing has carefully reviewed the existing policy and has suggested revisions thereto, to make it more adaptable to the present scenario;


WHEREAS, the proposal was presented to the members of the University Administrative Council (UAdCO), on the occasion of its 94th UAdCO Meeting held last 29 February 2012 at the PhilRootCrops Training Hall, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte and after hearing the merits of the proposed revisions, the UAdCO approved the revisions and has strongly recommended it for Approval, by the Board of Regents.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board, after careful perusal of the proposal, is convinced that the proposed revisions are meritorious and urgent;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the Revision of the Student Admission and Retention Policy of the College of Nursing, effective 1st Semester, SY 2012-2013.



6 9. Proposal to Amend Existing Policies Set in the College of Nursing

7 President Bacusmo requested the Dean of the College of Nursing to

8 present the proposal.

9 Professor Elni Mari Mendoza, Dean of the College of Nursing,

10 informed the Board that the College of Nursing would like to implement the

11 following:

- 12 a. change in the admission policy of the college to “*selectively accept*
- 13 *transferees and shiftees*”; and
- 14 b. change the one (1) subject failure policy to “*two (2) subjects*”;

15 Chairperson Defensor requested further clarification from Dean

16 regarding the proposed change in policy.

17 Prof. Mendoza clarified that for the first change in the admission

18 policy of the College, all prospective transferees and shiftees will be required

19 to take the College of Nursing Entrance Examination (CNEE) and only those

20 who get to the “passing mark” will be accepted, *provided that*, all other

21 University requirements are also met.

22 On the second policy change, students who fail in one subject will be

23 placed on probationary status with a warning that if another failure will

24 happen, they will be dropped from the program.

25 Chairperson Defensor inquired if there were any objections to the

26 proposal.
