WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to "exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines";

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (s) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Board of Regents of the University "to develop consortia and other forms of linkages with local government units, institutions and agencies, both public and private, local and foreign, and to appoint experts/specialists as consultants, or visiting or exchange professors, scholars, researchers, as the case may be";

WHEREAS, this invitation is a distinct honor and privilege accorded to the VSU considering that VSU and Hiroshima University (HU) still does not have formal "sisterhood ties."

WHEREAS, the 4<sup>th</sup> International Summer School aims to: (1) share the latest knowledge and technology on Marine Biology and Plant Metabolites; and (2) strengthen good relationships with sister universities specifically for educational advancement and international understanding;

**WHEREAS**, the invitation aims to improve ties between the two Universities as well as share the latest knowledge and technology on Marine Biology and Plant Metabolites;
