### BOR RESOLUTION NO. 261, s. 2019

A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING THE REQUEST OF DR. IVY C. EMNACE FOR AUTHORITY TO TRAVEL TO KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA TO ATTEND THE "2<sup>ND</sup> ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN FOOD-RELATED AREAS THROUGH PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM WITH UNIVERSITIES IN ASEAN REGION (PHASE II)" ORGANIZED BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FORESTRY AND FISHERIES (MAFF) OF JAPAN ON DECEMBER 3, 2019

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001, and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to "exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines";

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the CHED Chairperson issued an Unnumbered CHED Memorandum dated 24 July 2018, on the subject: <u>Guidelines in Securing Authority to Travel Abroad for State Universities and Colleges</u>;

**WHEREAS**, the said Unnumbered CHED Memorandum requires the following: 1) Assessment of the International Conference/Meeting issued by the International Affairs Office Staff – CHED Central Office; and 2) Board of Regents' Resolution;

WHEREAS, Dr. Ivy C. Emnace was issued by the CHED IAS, a Certification with Reference No. SUC2019-11-159 dated 07 November 2019 pursuant to the Memorandum from the Office-In-Charge dated 24 July 2018 titled: "Guidelines for Securing Authority to Travel Abroad for State Universities and Colleges;"
