BOR RESOLUTION NO. 106, s. 2016

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST OF THE VSU ISABEL TO UTILIZE THE REMAINING BALANCE OF CY 2015 UNAPPROPRIATED COLLECTIONS FROM FIDUCIARY FEES IN THE AMOUNT OF P658,017.11 FOR AUGMENTATION OF CAPITAL OUTLAY (CO) AND MAINTENANCE AND OPERATING EXPENSES (MOOE) SUBJECT TO EXISTING POLICIES AND GUIDELINES GOVERNING THE USE OF SUCH FUNDS

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9158 converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university, the Leyte State University, on 11 August 2001 and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (b) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "to receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University";

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (f) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "to authorize the construction or repair of its buildings, machineries, equipment and other facilities and the purchase and acquisition of real and personal properties, including necessary supplies, materials and equipment...";

WHEREAS, the VSU Isabel would like to utilize said funds as follows:

- A. Augmentation of Capital Outlay Funds (P385,350.00), to wit:
 - 1. Equipment (P203,058.10)
 - a. Sports Equipment P 55,000.00;
 - b. Information Technology Equipment P120,233.10; and
 - c. Technical and Scientific Equipment P27,825.00.
- B. Augmentation of MOOE Funds (P454,959.01), to wit:
 - 1. Travelling Expenses - P10,500.00;
 - 2. Printing Expenses P16,936.00;
 - 3. Office Supplies P215,070.00;
 - 4. Other MOOE P187,453.01;
 - 5. Repairs/Maintenance of School Bldgs. P25,000.00

WHEREAS, the proposal was discussed by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) on the occasion of the 122nd UADCO Meeting held last 01 December 2016 at the 2nd Floor, Center for Continuing Education (CEC) Building, VSU Main Campus, City of Baybay, Leyte and is strongly endorsing the proposal to the VSU Board of Regents for APPROVAL, as presented.
