# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED ORDER OF PRIORITY IN THE AWARDING OF STALL SPACES INTENDED FOR BUSINESS OR INCOME GENERATION IN THE VSU MARKET AND FAST FOOD AREAS

**WHEREAS**, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of R.A. 9158 specifically provides that the University "shall have the general powers of a corporation as set forth in the Corporation Law. The Administration of the University and the exercise of its powers shall be vested exclusively in the Board of Regents";

**WHEREAS**, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power "to enact rules and regulations, not contrary to law, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the University" as stipulated in Section 7, Paragraph (a) of R.A. 9158;

**WHEREAS**, the University maintains a substantial number of infrastructure in the Main Campus for the purpose of providing business opportunities to selected classes of personalities as part of the University's social conscience to its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, the University has seen the necessity of revising BOT Resolution No. 09, *s*, 1995 to take into account, the changing priorities of the University;

WHEREAS, the proposal was presented, discussed and approved by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) on the occasion of its 98<sup>th</sup> UADCO Meeting held last 13 November 2012 at the PhilRootCrops Conference Hall, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte and the UADCO is strongly endorsing the proposal to the VSU Board of Regents for Approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board thoroughly discussed the merits of the proposal and found it in order.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to approve the proposed Order of Priority in the Awarding of Stall Spaces Intended for Business or Income Generation in the VSU Market and Fast Food Areas, as presented *Provided That* a Business Contract/Memorandum of Agreement covering the lease operations shall be made and signed by the University and the awardee.
