PROPOSED GUIDELINES IN SEQUENCING THE GRANT OF THE POSITION OF UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR WITHIN THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM

(As approved by the VSU Board of Regents with the passage of BOR Resolution No. 54, s. 2013 dated 06 September 2013)

I. Qualifications

The position of University Professor is given to a faculty member who has reached the points for said position as specified in the National Budget Circular (NBC) 461 *Provided that* the CCE and QCE documents are also submitted for NBC 461 evaluation, and *Provided further that*, an official print-out from the Zonal Evaluation Center is submitted as proof on having attained said points.

II. Sequence in the Grant of the Position of University Professor

- A faculty member who first qualifies for the position based on an NBC/PASUC reclassification cycle, shall be given the position *Provided that* no other faculty member had previously qualified in an earlier evaluation cycle.
- 2. In the event that there is/are qualified faculty just waiting for vacancy to the University Professor position, he/she/they shall be given *First Priority* in the award of any vacant University Professor position.
- 3. In the event that there will be more than one (1) faculty member who will qualify for the position of University Professor in the same reclassification cycle, the faculty members will be ranked based on the total points earned as reflected in the official print-out from the Zonal Evaluation Center. Further, each qualified faculty member will be required to secure an individual print-out from the Zonal Evaluation Center to determine the total specific score of the faculty member under the criteria for awards which has no ceiling.
- The ranking for the second, third, etc. rank within the same reclassification cycle shall be determined based on the total individual points earned by the faculty members.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the length of service to VSU shall be used to break the tie.
