BOR RESOLUTION NO. 15, s. 2010

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF MONEY COLLECTED AS FEES FROM THE UNIVERSITY'S DOG IMPOUNDING CAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, Section 4, Paragraph (a) of R.A. 8292 empowers the Governing Board "to enact rules and regulations not contrary to law, as may be necessary to carry out the purposes and functions of the university or college";

WHEREAS, Section 4, Paragraph (b) of R.A. 8292 empowers the Governing Board "to receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the university or college in the manner it may determine in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the university or college";

WHEREAS, the University has launched a dog impounding campaign designed to make private dog owners take more responsibility for their pet animals and prevent the said pets from becoming public pests;

WHEREAS, in the course of the University's campaign, necessary expenses had to be incurred such as the purchase of needed chemical drugs for the humane disposition of animals determined to be "stray animals" and which were caught either through the traps or by the "dog police" organized for this purpose;

WHEREAS, the University Administration has found it necessary to provide a little incentive to the "dog police" for their efforts in catching astray dogs found roaming around the campus without collars or leash;

WHEREAS, Section 9 of R.A. 8292 provides that the Administrative Council "review and recommend to the Board of Regents/Trustees policies governing the administration, management and development planning of the University or College for appropriate action".

WHEREAS, the University Administrative Council unanimously approved the utilization of the money collected as fees from the University's dog impounding campaign, as proposed, on the occasion of the 81st UADCO Meeting held last 15 February 2010 at the University Review Center, Center for Continuing Education, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the utilization of the money collected as fees from the University's dog impounding campaign, as proposed
