EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

RATIONALE

VSU is a CHED Center for Excellence (COE) in Agriculture and a National University in Region VIII, it is mandated to provide leadership in developing highly competitive human resource, relevant scientific knowledge, and innovative technologies to support the sustainable development of the Visayas Region and the country.

The essence of the proposal is to request for BOR approval on the proposed official foreign business trip of Dr. Prose Ivy G. Yepes. As communicated by the CHED IAS, ASEAN University Network-Quality Assurance (AUN-QA) members are specifically invited to participate in this event.
