### BOR RESOLUTION NO. 95, s. 2015

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GRANT OF COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATIONS AGREEMENT (CNA) INCENTIVE TO ALL VSU EMPLOYEES IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND PESOS (18,000.00) EACH FOR 2015 SUBJECT TO DBM MEMORANDUM NO. 2015-2, s. 2015, DATED 23 NOVEMBER 2015 INCLUDING THE ASSESSMENT OF FEES ON NON-UNION MEMBERS

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9158 converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university, the Leyte State University, on 11 August 2001 and was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (b) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "to receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University";

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issued DBM Memorandum No. 2015-2, s. 2015 dated 23 November 2015 which provides the policies and guidelines governing the giving of CNA benefits to employees;

WHEREAS, the CNA benefits conform with the provisions contained in the approved Collective Negotiations Agreement (CNA) and that funds to be expended for the grant of CNA benefits will be charged against Agency savings in accordance with existing policies and guidelines governing the giving of CNA benefits per DBM Memorandum No. 2015-2, s. 2015 dated 23 November 2015 including the assessment of fees on non-union members and subject to refund in case of disallowance;

WHEREAS, the proposal was discussed and approved on the occasion of the 116<sup>th</sup> UADCO Meeting held last 16 November 2015 at 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Center for Continuing Education Building, VSU Main Campus, Visca, City of Baybay, Leyte and the UADCO is strongly endorsing the proposal for Approval by the VSU Board of Regents.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to approve the grant of CNA benefits to all VSU employees in the amount of P18,000.00 each for CY 2015 *subject to* DBM Memorandum No. 2015-2, s. 2015 dated 23 November 2015 including the assessment of fees on non-union members and *subject further to* refund in case of disallowance.



## COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATION AGREEMENT



### KNOW ALL MEN THESE PRESENTS:

This COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATIONS AGREEMENT (CNA) entered into by and between:

The VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU), a government-owned educational institution created by virtue of R.A 9158, with principal address at Visca, Baybay, Leyte, hereinafter referred to as "UNIVERSITY", represented by its President, Dr. Jose L. Bacusmo and the Governing Board;

-and-

The LSU Administrative Personnel Association (LSUAdPA), a legitimate employees' association representing the rank-and-file administrative employees of the Visayas State University, with Certificate of Registration No. 1586 dated 20 November 2006 issued by the Bureau of Labor Relations of the Department of Labor and Employment and the Civil Service Commission and with Certificate of Accreditation No. 701 dated 13 October 2008 issued by the Civil Service Commission with principal office at VSU Main Campus, Visca, Baybay, Leyte hereinafter referred to as the "UNION", represented by its Chairman of the Board, Mr. Daniel M. Tudtud, Jr. and its duly constituted negotiating Panel Members.

#### WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines and Executive Order No. 180 dated 01 June 1987, recognize and guarantee, among others, the right of government employees to self organization and collective negotiation;

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) recognize and support the right of government employees to self-organization and collective negotiation;

WHEREAS, Chapter 6, Title I, Book V of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 292, the Administrative Code of 1987, authorizes all employees of the government to form, join or assist employees' organizations of their own choosing for the furtherance and protection of their interests;


WHEREAS, E.O. No. 180 dated June 01, 1987 and CSC Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 55, s. 1990, provide that the terms and conditions of employment in the public sector, or improvement thereof, except those that are fixed by law, may be subject of negotiations between legitimate unions and government authorities;

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY, cognizant of the provisions of the 1987 Philippine Constitution and Executive Order No. 180, series of 1987, accepts its implementation, thus recognizes and supports the right of the rank-and-file administrative employees of the University to self-organization and collective negotiation;

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY and the UNION have agreed to promote the principle of shared responsibilities between the administrative employees and management on matters and decisions affecting the rights, benefits, privileges and interests of administrative employees;

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY and the UNION are duty bound to see to it that the standards of ethics, morality and fidelity to public service are observed;

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY has recognized the UNION as the sole and exclusive representative of its rank and file administrative employees;
