A RESOLUTIONAPPROVING THE PROMOTIONAL APPOINTMENTS OF MS. ROBERTA C. LEMOS FROM CHIEF ACCOUNTANT TO CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER AND MS. ERLINDA S. ESGUERRA FROM SUBJECT TO EXISTING RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES GOVERNING SUCH APPOINTMENTS

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to "exercise all the powers granted to the Board of Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines";

WHEREAS, among other powers granted to the Board of Regents is the power "to fix and adjust salaries of faculty members and administrative officials and employees ..." as stipulated in Section 7, Item (h) of R.A. 9158;

WHEREAS, the University regularly promotes administrative employees whenever there are vacancies brought about by retirement of the incumbent;

WHEREAS, the Non-Academic Personnel Board, after careful deliberation, has determined that Ms. Roberta C. Lemos and Ms. Erlinda S. Esguerra possess the qualifications for the assumption of the vacated plantilla positions in accordance with existing University policies and guidelines on promotions;

WHEREAS, the Human Resource Management and Development Office and the University Non-Academic Personnel Board strongly recommend the promotion of Ms. Roberta C. Lemos from Chief Accountant (SG-22) to Chief Administrative Officer (SG-24), and Ms. Erlinda S. Esguerra from Administrative Officer V (SG-18) to Chief accountant (SG-22), effective on the dates indicated.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board, is convinced that the recommendations of the NAPB are fair and adhere to thrust of government that only the best and the most fit should be in the government service;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the promotion of Ms. Roberta C. Lemos from Chief Accountant (SG-22) to Chief Administrative Officer (SG-24) and Ms. Erlinda S. Esguerra from Administrative Officer V (SG-18) to Chief accountant (SG-22), effective on the date indicated.
