APPROVING THE STUDY LEAVE WITH PAY OF MR. KENNETH ORAIZ EFFECTIVE 1ST SEMESTER 2024 - 2026 AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA, CANADA TO PURSUE DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN SOIL SCIENCE UNDER DOST-SEI FOREIGN GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT TO SIGN THE SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT

Whereas, the VSU Scholarship Committee for the Academic Staff endorses for approval by the Governing Board, among others, the scholarship of Mr. Kenneth Oraiz, faculty member of DSS;

Whereas, Mr. Oraiz will be pursuing the degree PhD in Soil Science at University of Alberta under DOST-SEI Foreign Graduate Scholarship effective 1st semester 2024-2026;

Whereas, the scholarship contract that outlines the terms and conditions of the scholarship grant under which the involved parties have agreed are crafted to help protect the faculty-recipient and the University;

- The scholar must return to the Philippines immediately upon completion of his/her degree program to render service physically to his/her sending institution on a full time basis for a period twice the length of time spent to complete his/her rendarios. scholarship.
- Any service rendered before the completion of the scholarship grant shall not be counted or considered as part of the service obligation.

Other Conditions

The qualified applicant must:

- Pursue an MS or PhD Program on a full-time basis for a maximum period of 24 or 48 months, respectively,
- Not avail of any other scholarships;
- Have a full-time commitment to the scholarship and must not engage in any form of employment during the scholarship period;
- Be willing to render the required service obligation based on the length of the scholarship-i.e., two years of service for every year of scholarship, or a fraction thereof;
