**BOR RESOLUTION NO. 266, s. 2019**

**A RESOLUTION COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM APPROVING BAC  
RESOLUTION NO. 258, DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND  
RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF AWARD TO THE  
LCRB FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 50-SEATER SCHOOL BUS  
(GOODS-19-29)**

**WHEREAS**, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of R.A. 9158 specifically empowers the Board of Regents of the University to “*exercise all the powers granted to the Directors of a corporation under Section 36 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 68 otherwise known as the Corporate Code of the Philippines*”;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7, Paragraph (f) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Board of Regents of the University “*to authorize the ... acquisition of real and personal properties, including necessary supplies and equipment...*”;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 75, Chapter 7, book VI of Executive Order (EO) No. 292 (Administrative Code of 1987) and Section 17 (b) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9970 (FY 2010) General Appropriation Act), no government funds shall be utilized for the purchase of Motor vehicle, except;

- iv. *those which are directly necessary in the business operations or government operations of front-line agencies.*

**WHEREAS**, Section 9 of Administrative Order (AO) No. 233 specifies that vehicles to be purchased should not fall within the category of “luxury vehicles”, such as the following:

- iv. *Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) with an engine displacement exceeding 2700cc if gasoline-fed; or 3000cc, if diesel-fed; and with an engine exceeding 4 cylinders.*

**WHEREAS**, the VSU Board Regents passed **BOR Resolution No. 146, s. 2018**, dated 4 October 2018 *Approving the Proposal to Purchase One (1) Unit 50-Seater School Bus for VSU Main Campus, Chargeable Against CY 2019 Capital Outlay Budget of the Main Campus Sourced from General Fund Based on the 2019 National Expenditure Program (NEP) but not to Exceed P10.0 Million.*;

**WHEREAS**, the Visayas State University (VSU) through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), advertised the Invitation to Apply for Eligibility and to Bid for the Project “**Supply and Delivery of 50-Seater School Bus**” in the PhilGEPS, VSU Website’s transparency seal and in conspicuous places within the premises of VSU for 25 calendar days;

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) passed BAC Resolution No. 258, s. 2019 dated 3 December 2019 *Declaring the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) and Recommending Approval of Award to the LCRB for the Supply and Delivery of 50-Seater School Bus (GOODS-19-29)*;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC Resolution No. 258, s. 2019 has resolved to declare **Hyundai Cebu Incorporated (HCI)**, from #21 A.S. Fortuna St., Banilad, Mandaue City, Cebu as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the Supply and Delivery of 50-Seater School valued at Eight Million Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (P8,270,000.00);

**WHEREAS**, the BAC Resolution No. 258, s. 2019 was reviewed and endorsed by the University Administrative Council (UADCO) for approval by the VSU Board of Regents (BOR) on 13 December 2019;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC Resolution 258, s. 2019 was reviewed by the BOR Finance Committee during its Special Meeting held last 20 December 2019 at the Conference Room, NEDA Regional Office VIII, Government Center Palo, Leyte;

**WHEREAS**, the BOR Finance Committee is strongly endorsing for the approval of BAC Resolution 258, 2019 by the VSU Board of Regents;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to approve BAC Resolution No. 258, s. 2019: Declaring Hyundai Cebu Incorporated (HCI) as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) for the Supply and Delivery of 50-Seater School Bus.
