A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE OFFERING OF FILIPINO AS A NEW MAJOR FIELD IN THE BACHELOR OF SECONDARY EDUCATION PROGRAM IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHED MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 18, s. 2004

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7, Paragraph (i) of R.A. 9158 empowers the Governing Board "to approve the curricula, institutional programs and rules of discipline drawn by the administrative and academic councils, as hereby provided";

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Republic Act No. 9158 – The Academic Council - stipulates the powers of the Academic Council to wit: "The academic council shall have the power to review and recommend the curricular offerings and rules of discipline of the university or college subject to the appropriate action of the Board of Regents/Trustees. It shall fix the requirements for the admission of students as well as for graduation and the conferment of degrees, subject to review and/or approval of the Board of Regents/Trustees through the President of the university or college";

WHEREAS, the College of Education (COE) of the Main Campus has sufficient number of faculty members with specialization in Filipino for the successful offering of the new major field in the Bachelor of Secondary Education;

WHEREAS, the proposal was coursed through the CHED Regional Office 8 which then issued an endorsement dated 02 September 2011 that "this Office is interposing no objection" on the said proposal; and

WHEREAS, the University Academic Council (UAC) has discussed and approved this proposal on the occasion of the 29th UAC meeting held at the University Convention Center last 03 October 2011 and passed UAC Resolution No. 22, s. 2011 "Approving the Proposal to Offer Filipino as a New Major Field in the BEEd Program in the Main Campus" and strongly endorsed said proposal to the Board of Regents for Approval.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to approve the offering of Filipino as a new major field in the Bachelor of Secondary Education in the Main Campus effective 1st Semester, SY 2012-2013.
