#### BOR RESOLUTION NO. 65, s. 2017

A RESOLUTION, COURSED THROUGH REFERENDUM, APPROVING THE PROMOTIONAL APPOINTMENT OF DR. IVY FE M. LOPEZ FROM FARM SUPERINTENDENT II (SG15) TO SENIOR SCIENCE RESEARCH SPECIALIST (SG19) OF THE PHILIPPINE CARABAO CENTER AT THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY EFFECTIVE 01 SEPTEMBER 2017

WHEREAS, the Leyte State University was created by virtue of Republic Act 9158 which converted the then Visayas State College of Agriculture (ViSCA) into a state university last 11 August 2001 which was later renamed Visayas State University (VSU) by virtue of R.A. 9437;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Carabao Center (PCC) was established by virtue of R.A. 7307, otherwise known as "An Act Creating the Philippine Carabao Center to Propagate and Promote the Philippine Carabao and for Other Purposes;"

**WHEREAS**, the PCC was established on the premise that it shall operate as a network of Philippine Carabao Centers located in various parts of Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao;

**WHEREAS**, the a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was executed by and between the then Visayas State College of Agriculture *now* the Visayas State University and the Philippine Carabao Center in 1995;

**WHEREAS**, Item 1.2 of Article 1 of the MOA stipulates, to wit: "The Center Director at VSU and other employees off PCC shall be appointed by the University President in accordance with Sections 10 and 11(e) of R.A. 7307;"

**WHEREAS**, Article 5 of the MOA stipulates, to wit: "Except those ViSCA staff who are seconded to the PCC, all full-time employees of PCC at ViSCA are considered employees of PCC and shall not have double compensation, notwithstanding the fact that their appointments are issued at ViSCA;"

**WHEREAS**, the PCC Central Office through the PCC Executive Director, Dr. Arnel N. del Barrio, has recommended the promotional appointment of Dr. Ivy Fe M. Lopez, a full-time personnel of the PCC, to the permanent position of Senior Science Research Specialist (SG19);

WHEREAS, the VSU Non-Academic Personnel Board (NAPB) during its 23 May 2017 meeting, acted favorably on the promotion of Dr. Ivy Fe M. Lopez from the position of Farm Superintendent II to Senior Science Research Specialist;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to Approve the promotional appointment of Dr. Ivy Fe M. Lopez, a full-time personnel of the PCC, from Farm Superintendent II (*SG*15) to the position of Senior Science Research Specialist (*SG*19) effective 01 September 2017;

### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This AGREEMENT, made and executed by and between:

- 1. THE PHILIPPINE CARABAO CENTER, Department of Agriculture, with principal office at 5F, DCIEC Building, NIA Complex, EDSA, Diliman, Quezon City, represented herein by its Executive Director, Libertado C. Cruz, hereinafter referred to as PCC;
- 2. THE VISAYAS STATE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE a State institution, situated and with principal office at Baybay, Leyte, represented herein by its President, Honorable Samuel S. Go hereinafter referred to as ViSCA;

### WITNESSETH: That-

WHEREAS, the Philippine Carabao Center (PCC) was established by the Philippine Government by virtue or Republic Act No. 7307, otherwise known as An Act Creating the Philippine Carabao Center to Propagate and Promote the Philippine Carabao and for Other Purposes:

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act 7307 designated the Department of Agriculture to have the supervision and control of PCC, and that under Section 12 of the said Act provided that one of the thirteen (13) centers shall be located at Baybay, Leyte, hereinafter referred to as PCC at ViSCA;

WHEREAS, the PCC was established on the premise that it shall operate as a network of Philippine Carabao centers located in various parts of Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao;

WHEREAS, the experience of the forerunner of PCC, which was the Philippine Carabao Research and Development Center (PCRDC); proved that the system of Center networking could enhance cooperation among member institutions of the network, resulting in maximum use of resources, manpower, economy and the strengthening of research and development programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above and their mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the PCC and Viscat, have mutually agreed and stipulated as follows:

# ARTICLE 1 - GENERAL PRINCIPLES.

### Both parties hereto AGREE:

- 1.1 That all the existing facilities, programs, equipment and animals at ViSCA which were acquired/used in support of the carabao program shall be, and are hereby, transferred to PCC conformably to Section 18 of Republic Act 7307.
- 1.2 The Center Director at ViSCA and other employees of PCC at ViSCA shall be appointed by President in accordance with Sections 10 and 11 (e) of Republic Act 7307.
- 1.3 The Center Director at ViSCA shall exercise his functions and prerogatives in accordance with Section 11 of Republic Act 7307.
- 1.4 The PCC at ViSCA or its officers and employees shall not enter into any contract or memorandum of agreement with any other funding agencies for the purpose of receiving donations from local and foreign sources without the knowledge and consent of PCC in accordance with Section 5, paragraph (g) of Republic Act 7307.

### ARTICLE 2 - OBLIGATIONS OF VISCA

- In line with the sanctions provided in Sections 5 and of Republic Act 7307, the ViSCA shall:
- 2 1 Make available its faculty and other staff and personnel, as well as its laboratory and various facilities needed by the PCC at Visca, without prejudice to its own needs.
- 2 2 Allow the PCC at ViSCA to utilize the facilities and staff of accounting, budget, cash personnel and internal audit divisions, and other ViSCA offices needed in processing business transactions and operation of PCC at ViSCA at a cost representing the administrative cost released to the Center.
- 2.3 Receive the remittance of fund by PCC for the operation of PCC at ViSCA, and shall keep a separate account therefore in the name of PCC at ViSCA.
- 2.4 In matter of disbursements, adhere closely to the approved programs/projects by the PCC Executive Director.
- 2.5 Follow government accounting and auditing rules and regulations in the disbursement of PCC funds, specifically Commission on Audit Circular No. 92-380, dated June 23, 1992.

- 2.6 Submit an audited monthly financial report showing therein the total funds received and the expenditures incurred, duly itemized in accordance with the breakdown approved by PCC and with the attached sample of financial report. All expenditures paid from PCC funds shall be supported by proper invoices, receipts and similar documents for proper auditing procedures. This will be submitted to the COA Auditor station at ViSCA for safekeeping and post-audit purposes.
- 2.7 Make available all records of PCC of ViSCA to authorized PCC officials who may wish to review/inspect said records.
- 2.8 Submit a quarterly report of operations of PCC at ViSCA, with a statement of the status of the programs and projects, including problems encountered, if any, together with the corresponding recommendations therefore, and accomplishment of objectives.

### ARTICLE 3 - OBLIGATIONS OF PCC.

#### The PCC shall:

- 3.1 Approve the annual budget of the PCC at ViSCA and remit to ViSCA the amount sub-alloted to PCC at ViSCA for its operations in implementing the goals and objectives enunciated in Republic Act 7307.
- 3 2 Allow VisCA to use the staff and facilities of PCC at VisCA for purposes of research and instruction at VisCA, without prejudice to the functions and activities of PCC.
- Review and evaluate from time to time through the Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation Division of PCC the progress of the programs and projects, and confer with the Center director the results of such evaluations.
- 3 4 Pay annually the administrative cost, equivalent to five percent (5%) of the sub-alloted budget of PCC at ViSCA, but not more than THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND (P300,000.00) annual, whichever is lower, for the use of the administrative facilities at ViSCA in pursuing the business transactions of PCC at ViSCA. The rates paid to ViSCA technical and guidelines formulated by the National Research and Development System of DOST.
- 3 5 Suspend the release of funds whenever there is an evident failure in the progress of the operations, for causes clearly within the full control of the Center Director, Provided, That in case of violation of any provisions of this agreement, and effective upon receipt of written notice of suspension, ViSCA shall cease/desist from disbursing funds until further written notice to resume disbursements.





# ARTICLE 4 - LIABILITY CLAUSE.

The PCC at ViSCA shall have full responsibility for the operations/implementation of the projects and programs under it. The PCC shall not be held liable for claims of losses, damages, injury or harm suffered by third persons and/or their properties resulting from, during and in the course of the undertaking of PCC at ViSCA by virtue of this Agreement, or as result of the act, ommission or negligence of the latter, its officers, employees and hired personnel.

### ARTICLE 5 - EMPLOYER/EMPLOYEE RELATIONSHIP.

Except those ViSCA staff who are seconded to PCC, all fulltime employees of PCC at ViSCA are considered employees of PCC
and shall not have double compensation, notwithstanding the fact
that their appointments are issued by ViSCA. Accordingly, unless
funds have been provided by PCC, the ViSCA shall not be liable to
the employees and officers of PCC at ViSCA for any and all claims
for salaries, wages and allowances and other benefits under the
Civil Service law, rules and regulations, and other social
regulation. Claims for payment shall have prior approval by the
Center director, provided that funds are available therefor.
However, all position classifications shall be patterned after
those of PCC and the promulgations on the same by ViSCA
concerning personnel benefits shall be adopted by PCC at ViSCA.

## ARTICLE 6 - PERIOD OF AGREEMENT.

This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon the date hereof. All provisions under this Agreement shall be in full force and effect unless terminated for cause by either party hereto, upon written notice for at least nine (9) months prior to date of the proposed termination of this Agreement.

### ARTICLE 7 - AMENDMENTS, MODIFICATIONS AND ALTERATIONS

All amendments, modifications and alterations of any of the terms of this Agreement shall be made in a separate written instrument jointly signed by the parties hereto, which shall thereafter form part of this Agreement.
