Item no. 1- Slow wi-fi connection- Action taken: Inquiry of the bandwidth, cleaning Schedule, regular monitoring

The UCCO head, Engineer Sean Villagonzalo informed me that the Library has been allotted 15 Mbps of our Globe subscription. Basing on our average daily statistics for use of the Wi-fi connection, 147.59 vouchers is used for the Wi-fi and according to him 15Mbps bandwidth cannot fully satisfy the need of the customers at one time. If budget allows we will subscribe for an increased bandwidth. Maintain regular cleaning of computers and close monitoring of sites visited by customers/users for balanced use.

Item no. 2- Hot and noisy-

Action taken: Position letter to VSU President

Immediately after the receipt of the customer's feedback, the Chief Librarian wrote a letter stating the feedback of a customer and past users of the hotness and noise of the Library which was originally meant to be a green library building but due to climate change discomforts were felt by the users and the working staff thus a letter request for air conditioning of the Library was suggested to the President. Top management review meeting was conducted and the President expressed his plans, and one of which was the air-conditioning of the Library.

The University Library as the Learning Resource Center has been the haven for those who hunger for academic excellence and intellectual enhancement and for the Library to be globally competitive it has to be greened with resources for research, fun, leisure reading with relaxing environment. I have been receiving comments regarding our library which is hot and lately the internal auditor of ISO commented that there are areas that are warm and hot. As the chief librarian I envy those offices which are fully air conditioned. It has been three years that we have transferred to this three-storey building which is spacious with electric fans but often times our customers gave us feedbacks that the Library is hot and cannot concentrate in their research and studies.

The hotness of the library seemed to give us mental sluggishness that comes with a day that is just too hot. There's actually a scientific basis for this, according to an article in Scientific American, the energy the body expends trying to cool itself down takes away from our ability to think and reason. When offices are air conditioned, people are able to work better and make better decisions. Proper air-conditioning and ventilation are an important aspect of both reading rooms, where many visitors read, study or use computers, and library halls, where paper slowly acquires its aroma. The Library has these specific needs where the required temperature and humidity levels must be carefully maintained, so the very old archived books are properly cared for and, consequently, have their lifetimes prolonged. I understand that this Library was conceptualized as a green library but, the global warming caught us with this warm situation.

Mr. President, these are few of the reasons why we need to fully air conditioned our Library. I believed that maybe this could be one of your priorities in your second term as our beloved President of this university.

I hope and pray that this request be given importance for our university to be customer-satisfied which is our utmost objective as the Learning Resource Centre.
